

#### WHY TRAFFIC SAFETY MATTERS IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

Every year, there are **over 10,000** reported crashes in Philadelphia, taking the lives of nearly **100 people**. State Road has two severe crashes and a higher crash rate than average Philadelphia streets.





On State Road between 2014 to 2018, there were **48 reported crashes**.

# STATE ROAD REPAVING & CORRIDOR SAFETY PROJECT

### SAFETY PROJECT GOALS

The primary goal of this project is to make State Road safe for neighbors walking, taking transit, biking, and driving. The new layout on this part of State Road will help to provide a neighborhood-scale roadway for this residential corridor by:

- Calming vehicle speeds by reorganizing roadway space;
- Shortening crossing distances in front of moving vehicle lanes for people walking;
- **Upgrading an important link in the bikeway network with protected bicycle lanes** to protect people walking and bicycling and encourage active transportation and recreation, and;
- Connecting residential areas along State Road to existing and planned trails along the Delaware River and the East Coast Greenway.
