#### Dear Allyson,

This application involves the proposed construction of a residential roof deck and pilot house on a portion of the roof at 241 Chestnut Street. The work is proposed to be part of the sixth floor condominium (Unit G), which previously had roof access to a deck located on the roof of 239 Chestnut street that was destroyed by a fire in 2018, with that building since being demolished. The 239 Chestnut St roof deck was originally accessed from the 241 Chestnut street roof, by way of a large hinged roof hatch with stairs from the apartment below. It was constructed in 2006, was approved by the Historic Commission at that time and had an easement allowing for its use.

This proposed project is to rebuild a smaller deck to be located on 241 Chestnut Street, with pilot house access as required by the building code and with setbacks appropriate for the setting. The pilot house is proposed to be 154 gsf, with the roof deck at 420 sq. feet. in area. The original 239 roof deck was approx. 850 sq. feet in area.

The new deck is proposed to "step" with the existing roof's slope to reduce visibility from below. The deck is to be set back 10' from the west façade of the 241 building and approximately 20' from the face of the cornice to the south. The deck's railing will be of painted steel balusters with cable system. Its arrangement and relationship to the original deck, are shown in the attached drawings.

The applicant reviewed the project with The Old City District's Economic Development Committee on April 7, and they unanimously voted in support of the project.

Staff recommended to the Arch Committee that the design be recommended for approval and felt that it was in compliance with HC Standards and the Roof Guideline, IF the pilot house was reduced in size. The Arch. Committee reviewed the project as submitted to the HC Staff without revisions and at the Architectural Committee meeting on April 13, the project was denied.





The attached drawings are response to the Architectural Committee's comments as follows:

- 1. Reduce the width of the pilot house by 3'-8". (11'-0" overall width shown. The overall width is as wide as it is, because of a pipe/duct shaft that needs to be incorporated into the construction. An HVAC closet, shown at the pilot house level will be relocated within the apartment below.)
- 2. Reduce the length of the pilot house by 9". (This allows for a minimum landing size at the deck level.)
- 3. Reduce the height of the pilot house by 9". (This allows for a door height of 6'-8" and a ceiling height of 7'-6". The design needs a header over the doors, because the rating required by the adjacent party wall, necessitates the roof framing to run north-south.)
- 4. The Arch. Committee had no negative comments about the deck's dimensions, railing and arrangement
- 5. One member suggested that double doors in the pilot house may be a problem with wind. The owner wishes to have double doors, but will take steps with the specification protect the doors from "wind-whip".
- 6. The Committee asked for information on the type of glass that is proposed, suggesting that dark tints, or colors, would be inappropriate. The drawings are revised to show that clear, low-E, low-reflectance glass is to be used.

With these changes integrated into the design, the applicant and Owner are respectfully asking the Commission to review the attached application and approve the project as modified.




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
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
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
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















MAP OF RENDERING LOCATIONS






