COVID Ground-Rules

What is Vision Zero?



Vision Zero is a policy that states clearly that traffic deaths are <u>preventable</u> and <u>unacceptable</u>.

VISION ZERO CORE PRINCIPLES:

- Human life takes priority over mobility;
- Human error is inevitable and unpredictable;
- People are inherently vulnerable and speed is a fundamental predictor of crash survival;
- Safe design behaviors, education, and enforcement are essential contributors to a safe system.



We will use this time to share information and data about Mantua and learn from the real experiences of community members. In Mantua, many people do not have access to a motor vehicle.


Vehicles per Household in Mantua, Philadelphia

How people in Mantua get to work.




71% of working people in Mantua rely on a method of transportation other than a personal vehicle to go to work

55% of the working population of Mantua **rely on walking or public transportation** to go to work



Traffic Safety Toolbox: Short Term

6-18 Months to implement

Examples: Signal Timing, Cones/Panels, Paint, and Flex Posts

Signal timing

Define pedestrian crossing areas with cones, paint, flex posts







Traffic Safety Toolbox: Mid Term

18-36 Months to implement

Examples: road layout, speed cushions

New road layout changing travel, parking, or bike lanes

3+ Years to implement

Examples: plazas, planters, curb extensions, concrete
