REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF REQUIREMENT FOR INSTALLATION PERMIT/OPERATING LICENSE - DRAFT

A facility may submit this form to find out if a planned project requires an installation permit or operating license.

- 1. This Request for Determination form must be submitted to and reviewed by AMS <u>prior to</u> the installation or modification of any equipment involved in the project.
- 2. Beginning 2021, this form has the following fees, as per 25 Pa Code Section 127.709:
 - (a) The owner or operator of a source that meets the definition of small business stationary source set forth in 35 P.S. § 4003 shall pay a fee equal to:
 - (i) Four hundred dollars (\$400) for requests for determination filed during calendar years 2021—2025.
 - (ii) Five hundred dollars (\$500) for requests for determination filed during calendar years 2026—2030.
 - (iii) Six hundred dollars (\$600) for requests for determination filed for the calendar years beginning with 2031.
 - (b) The owner or operator of a source that does not meet the criterion in paragraph (1) shall pay a fee equal to:
 - (i) Six hundred dollars (\$600) for requests for determination filed during calendar years 2021—2025.
 - (ii) Eight hundred dollars (\$800) for requests for determination filed during calendar years 2026—2030.
 - (iii) One thousand dollars (\$1,000) for requests for determination filed for the calendar years beginning with 2031.
- 3. "Small business stationary source." A stationary source that: (in 35 P.S. § 4003)
 - (a) is owned or operated by a person that employs one hundred (100) or fewer individuals;
 - (b) is a small business as defined in the Small Business Act (Public Law 85-536, 15 U.S.C. § 78a et seq.);
 - (c) is not a major stationary source;
 - (d) does not emit fifty (50) tons per year of any regulated pollutant; and
 - (e) emits less than seventy-five (75) tons per year of all regulated pollutants.
- 4. You may include a copy of the manufacturer's specifications or other information for the proposed equipment. We do not want a large submittal, just a few pages giving the basic information is fine.
- 5. All dry cleaning and auxiliary equipment must meet the requirements of Air Management Regulation XI

- 6. All information in the application is available to the public. If you wish to keep some information confidential, please submit this information separately, stamped confidential, along with a letter requesting that it be kept confidential and justification for keeping it confidential. AMS will review the request and determine if it can be kept confidential.
