Failure to secure the required hours of continuing education, and have them in your EMS registry record will result in a lapse of registration. Lapse of registration processes will require certification examinations to be completed before a certification is reinstated.

**Please Note:** Effective January 1, 2020 EMSVO's will be required to have the required EMSVO hours recorded on their Continuing Education Record to reregister their EMSVO certification.
