
Mechanical Street Cleaning Pilot Program 2019 - 2022

- Identifies best practices for offering a residential mechanical street sweeping program
- Utilizes a hybrid approach consisting of: backpack blowers and hand brooms to remove debris from sidewalks and curbs; mechanical brooms, and trash compactors to capture larger illegally dumped items.
- Program supported by SWEEP unit which issues tickets for litter on routes.






Litter Index: Pilot areas have an average Litter Index rating more than 2.0, indicating a significant amount of litter



Phase I Results (2019 – April 15 – November 30)

- Six areas cleaned weekly by six crews consisting of 5 laborers and an equipment operator
- Tonnage: 971.16 (1,942,320 pounds)
- GPS Mileage within pilot area only: 13,353.30
- Residents in the pilot areas favorably received program according to a survey conducted by the Streets Dept. in conjunction with the Mayor's Policy Office.



Phase II Results (2021 - Aug 9 - November 30)

- 6 areas cleaned
- Removed 218,620 lbs. (109.31 tons) of debris
- Miles swept: 3,333
- SWEEP Officers issued 1,533 parking warnings
- Remaining 8 areas to be swept in 2022 as Phase II continues.





Phase II - 2021 Alternate Street Parking




- Alternate street parking for mechanical street cleaning designated for streets at least 14-feet wide, allowing for cars to be moved to an adjacent cross-street for parking.
- Smaller streets to receive mechanical street cleaning with small brooms, hand cleaning personnel or ATLV sidewalk sweepers.
- "No Parking" signs posted on designated blocks in 6 of 6 cleaned areas in 2021.
- Program operates 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. in two-hour intervals each day Monday through Thursday beginning at 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (e.g. 9AM to 11AM; 11AM to 1PM and 1PM to 3PM.). No sweeping on holidays.




Phase II Expansion 2022 (April 4 – November 30)

- Signs presently posted in 6 of the 14 areas identified for Phase II
- Streets' Traffic Division continues to post signs on designated blocks as resources become available
- PPA to conduct rolling enforcement program. Ticketing begins one month following the April 4th start of the program in areas where signs are posted. Rolling enforcement in remaining areas as signs installed, with one month warning period.
- To minimize the inconvenience during parking restrictions, Streets has designed an app for residents to stay updated on the cleaning progress of a street sweeper assigned to a route.





Strawberry Mansion Boundary: Diamond St to Lehigh Ave, from Sedgley to 33rd Sts.




South Philly Boundary: McKean St to Oregon Ave from 8th to 4th Sts.

PHASE II PILOT PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Mechanical Street Cleaning Pilot Program is part of the City of Philadelphia's commitment to reduce trash and litter conditions in the City's most vulnerable communities. Mechanical street cleaning is an effective tool in reducing litter from city streets and preventing trash and debris from entering the water systems.

With the support of Mayor Jim Kenney's \$62 million investment over five years in street cleaning, the Streets bepartment launched phase II in 14 neighorhoods identified through the Litter Index as having the highest concertration of litter. These areas have been identified as requiring additional city services to supplement cleaning efforts in the area.

Effective April 4, 2022, the Mechanical Street Cleaning Pilot Program will launch in the following residential areas:

North Central: Broad to 22nd from Glenwood to Diamond

South Philly: McKean to Oregon from 4th to 8th

Southwest: Woodland to Kingsessing from 49th to Cemetery Ave.

Strawberry Mansion: Diamond to Lehigh from Sedgley to 33rd

Frankford: Bridge to Adams from Griscom St to Torresdale

Germantown: Berkley to Chelten from Pulaski to Wakefield

Kensington: 2nd to Kensington from Tioga to Lehigh Ave.

Logan: Godfrey to Roosevelt Blvd from Broad to 5th Sts.

Nicetown: Broad to Clarissa from Hunting Park to Windrim

Paschall: 58th to 70th from Greenway to Dicks

Point Breeze: Christian to McKean from Broad to 24th Sts.

Port Richmond: Kensington to Aramingo from Tioga to Lehigh

West Fairhill: 5th to 13th from Glenwood to Susquehanna

West Philly: Parkside to Girard from 52nd to 40th Sts.

The program runs through November 30th to coincide with warmer-weathered months and decrease the potential for snow and ice.

Some streets in each pilot area will have sidewalk cleaning maintenance along with mechanical broom cleaning weekly.

To facilitate a more detailed cleaning, residents on select streets will be required to move their vehicles. Residents on those streets may notice no parking signs installed and are required to adhere to the posted timeframes beginning the week of April 4 to avoid enforcement measures. Mechanical Street Cleaning in Philadelphia operates annually on select routes April 1 through November 30. Residents should foliow posted "no parking" signs to allow the mechanical broom to clean the roadways from curb to curb at the scheduled time.

Authorized Philadelphia ticketing agencies will issue warnings on vehicles parked on the roadway during specified no parking times during the first month of the Phase II pilot On or after May 1st, posted "no parking" signs will be enforced with assessed fines.

Mechanical sweeping will take place Monday through Thursday, except holidays, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. No service will be performed on City-observed holidays. Crews will resume cleaning the following week.

Cleaning times on streets are staggered and/or occur on alternate days to minimize inconvenience to residents. Alternate street parking intervals occur between the hours of 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.; 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The following is the sequence of the mechanical cleaning pilot in each area:

- Streets Department laborers equipped with back pack blowers and hand brooms will clean some pilot routes.
- Mechanical brooms will follow cleaning crews once debris is blown off sidewalks and curb lines.
- To ensure cleaning is maintained, SWEEP Officers will patrol neighborhoods to address Sanitation code violations related to litter and dumping.

The Mechanical Street Cleaning Pilot Program is a partnership between the Streets Department and the residents of Philadelphia:

The City will provide resources to:

- Mechanically Clean Streets Weekly
- Remove litter and debris from sidewalks
- Collect illegally dumped material

Residents in the pilot area are asked to:

- · Follow posted "no parking" signs
- Place trash and recycling collections out on designated day at authorized location between 7p.m. the day before and 7a.m. on trash day
- Place trash and recycling collections out in proper containers / bags to prevent spillage
- · Only set household trash for pick up.
- Sweep sidewalks and gather debris. Do not sweep into the street


