**WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS**

Health Commissioner and Board President Cheryl Bettigole, MD, MPH called the meeting to order at 7:26 PM.

**RESCISSION OF REGULATION RELATING TO THE SALE OF FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS**

**AMENDMENT TO THIRD CONSOLIDATED AND RESTATED SUPPLEMENTAL EMERGENCY REGULATION GOVERNING THE CONTROL AND PREVENTION OF COVID-19 (CONSOLIDATED SAFETY MEASURES FOR FULL REOPENING AND DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY)**

Jo Rosenberger-Altman described the changes proposed in this Amendment. The changes include showing that the City has met the *All Clear* COVID Response Level, that the mask mandate schools and childcare settings is no longer applicable, institutes a one-week post-spring

break masking period, and gives the Health Commissioner the authority to reinstate any of these requirements.

Dr. Bettigole asked if there was a desire to move on this Amendment.

Dr. McNeal moved; Dr. Ibrahim seconded.

**Motion for approval of the Amendment to the Regulation approved unanimously.**
