PUBLIC ADVOCATE OUTREACH REPORT

All members of the public expressing an interest in the Special Rate Proceeding were provided information directly regarding the opportunity to participate in the TAP-R Reconciliation proceeding. This determination was made in order to avoid confusion among those potentially providing public input, by focusing outreach efforts first on the Special Rate Proceeding (with hearings taking place on March 23), with follow up outreach for the TAP-R proceeding (with the hearing taking place on March 31).

Of the members of the public to whom outreach was conducted for the Special Rate Proceeding, interest was expressed by staff of one City Councilmember and one non-profit organization, both of whom were provided additional, supplemental information and explanation regarding the TAP-R proceeding in order to provide public input, if desired.
