

Senior Citizen Tax Freeze Program - COOP Application

The Senior Citizen Tax Freeze Program (SCTX) "freezes" your Real Estate Tax if you meet certain age and income requirements. This stops your property taxes from increasing, even if your property assessment or tax rate increases.

This application is for **new applicants only!** If you participated in this program last year, you are automatically enrolled this year. If your deed changes for any reason, you **must** reapply. Everyone must complete pages 1-2 of this application. Please include your proof of age with this application. The Department of Revenue will contact you if we need income documents.

The deadline to apply is **January 31, 2023.** Early filers should apply by **September 13, 2022** to see approval reflected on your 2023 Real Estate Tax bill. Applicants approved after this date will receive a second bill.
