


Everyone Deserves Food

Food Bank Tips

1. Stay Home if You are Sick

Many food banks allow you to have a friend or family member pick up food for you, but call the food bank to confirm. Turn to the next page for information on free food delivery services in Philadelphia.

2. Bring Your Own Bags

Bring more bags than you think you will need, and make sure they are strong. Some food banks have bags, but they are often small and weak.

3. Wear a Mask and Gloves

Food banks are often crowded, making it hard to physical distance. Wear a mask and gloves, even if you are fully vaccinated. Wear double masks if you are not fully vaccinated.



4. Arrive Early

Many food banks close when they run out of food, so try to arrive as early as possible...at least ten minutes before pick-up-time if you can.

5. Call Food Bank Before Visiting

Food bank schedules and requirements change often. Please call the food bank before you visit to confirm when they are open, when the pickup time is, and any requirements they have.

Delivery Services

These services can deliver free food while you isolate and quarantine for COVID-19.

Public Benefits

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides monthly funds for those under a certain monthly income level for buying groceries.

To apply, visit bit.ly/IHS-SNAP, or visit your local county assistance office. Call 1-800-692-7462 for questions (1-800-451-5886 for individuals with hearing impairments).



If you need help applying for SNAP, call **The SNAP Hotline** at 215-430-0556, available Monday through Friday from 9am to 4pm. An experienced counselor from the Coalition Against Hunger will help you with the SNAP application process.

Resources Connects offers resources to help with food, utilities, transportation and more at communityresourceconnects.org

BenePhilly offers one-on-one help for finding and applying for public benefits for food, taxes, utilities, college, and health benefits. A counselor will help you fill out applications and follow up on the status of your applications. Call (844) 848-4376 to begin service.

Senior Food Box provides a monthly box of nutrition-packed food that help older adults meet their daily nutrition recommendations.

- Applicants must be aged 60 years or older and live under 130% of the poverty line.

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (or WIC) offers food assistance and nutrition education to:

- Pregnant women
- Breastfeeding women, for up to one year postpartum
- Women up to six months postpartum, who are not breastfeeding
- Infants and Children under 5 years old, including foster children

Eligibility is based on income, household size, and medical risk. Schedule an appointment to apply by calling 1-800-WIC-WINS (1-800-942-9467) or by visiting: **bit.ly/IHS-Help-WIC**
