ADVISORY ALERT

July 11, 2022

On June 22, 2022, Mayor Kenney signed into law [Bill No. 220360](#), which amended the City's Ethics Code to:

- Expand protections for individuals who submit complaints to or seek advice from the Board of Ethics and to prohibit any person from discriminating or retaliating against someone for doing so.
- Prohibit interference with or obstruction of Board proceedings or the participation of any person in such proceedings.

The Board expects to update Board Regulation No. 2 in the coming months to reflect this amendment. The Board also expects to provide additional educational materials about the anti-retaliation and anti-interference provisions of Section 20-606(1)(j).
