GENERAL INFORMATION

Please utilize the information provided in the links below to ensure that all permit applications are as correct as possible, enabling an efficient review and approval times, thereby keeping requested moves on schedule.

- If you are trying to access the website, visit to the APPLICATION.
- If you are unsure whether you do or do not need a permit, see the **REQUIREMENTS**.
- If you are unclear of the application, payment, or approval, see the PROCEDURES.
- If you are trying to plan your move schedule, see the <u>DATE & TIME RESTRICTIONS</u>.
- If you are trying to plan your move route, see the **ROUTE RESTRICTIONS**.
- If you require law enforcement accompaniment, schedule a POLICE ESCORT.
- If you must travel over a subway line, you may need a SEPTA PERMIT.
- If you must travel through a city park, you may need a **PARK PERMIT**.
- If you must travel on non-city state/federal routes, you may need a PennDOT PERMIT.
- If you require additional information, please refer to the CONTACT LIST.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A *City of Philadelphia Special Hauling Permit* is <u>not</u> required when traveling exclusively on interstate highways; only a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit is required.
- 2. A City of Philadelphia Standard Special Hauling Permit is required when traveling on any city street, state route, or interstate highway in the City of Philadelphia and the vehicle and/or load is:
 - over 40'-0" long as a single vehicle.
 - over 60'-0" long as a combination vehicle.
 - over 70'-0" long as a combination transporting articles that are non-divisible as to length.
 - over 8'-0" wide (8'-6" for non-divisible loads operating on highways having a width of 20'-0" or more).
 - over 13'-6" high.
 - over 80,000 pounds or the maximum gross vehicle weight.

In <u>many</u> cases, a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit will also be required. Contact PennDOT by calling (610) 205-6786 or visit https://apras.penndot.gov/.

- 3. A City of Philadelphia Super Load Special Hauling Permit is required when traveling on any city street, state route, or interstate highway in the City of Philadelphia and the vehicle and/or load is:
 - over 160'-0" long.
 - over 16'-0" wide.
 - over 16'-0" high.
 - over 201,000 pounds.

In <u>all</u> cases, a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit will also be required. Contact PennDOT by calling (610) 205-6786 or visit https://apras.penndot.gov/.

When traveling in the city, certain on-street circumstances may require the relocation of parked vehicles. Therefore, it is recommended that companies secure a tow truck to accompany Super Load moves.

- 4. A City of Philadelphia Impounded Special Hauling Permit is required when the vehicle is currently impounded; "Yes" must be selected on the application for the indicator question that asks whether or not the vehicle is currently impounded.
- 5. A City of Philadelphia Police Escort is <u>not</u> required when traveling exclusively on interstate highways; only Commonwealth of Pennsylvania requirements apply:

6. A City of Philadelphia Police Escort is required:

- a. when traveling on any city street, state route, or interstate highway in the City of Philadelphia and the vehicle and/or load is:
 - over 75'-0" long.
 - over 11'-5" wide.
 - over 14'-0" high.
 - over 145,000 pounds.
- b. when either the Streets Department or Police Department deems it necessary due to the nature of the proposed move.

The City of Philadelphia Truck Enforcement Unit responsible for Police Escorts operates from the Navy Yard at the end of South Broad Street. Contact Police Escorts by calling (215) 685-1554 or visit https://phl.secure.force.com/ROWS/.

- 7. The Delaware River Port Authority maintains jurisdiction over the following structures:
 - Ben Franklin Bridge
 - Betsy Ross Bridge
 - Commodore Barry Bridge
 - Walt Whitman Bridge

A DRPA permit is required the vehicle and/or load is over 80,000 pounds. A DRPA police escort is required when the vehicle and/or load is over 8'-6" wide. To contact DRPA, see the CONTACT LIST or visit http://www.drpa.org/.

- 8. The Burlington County Bridge Commission maintains jurisdiction over the following structures:
 - Burlington-Bristol Bridge
 - Tacony-Palmyra Bridge

A BBBC permit is required the vehicle and/or load is over 110,000 pounds. A BBBC police escort is required when the vehicle and/or load is over 10'-0" wide. To contact the BBBC, see the CONTACT LIST or visit http://www.bcbridges.org/.

PROCEDURES

- 1. All standard applications will be analyzed within <u>three (3) full business days</u> of submission, while super load applications may take longer and require additional lead time; please plan accordingly.
- 2. The schedule of application filing fees for various permit move types are as follows:
 - \$85.00 for a Standard One-Way, One-Time Move
 - \$170.00 for a Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move
 - \$170.00 for an Impounded Standard One-Way, One-Time Move
 - \$340.00 for an Impounded Super Load One-Way, One-Time Move
 - Varying Rate for a Non-Standard Move (AUTHORIZED USE ONLY)
 - o used for certain government agencies, book permits with or without multiple routes, and other miscellaneous special situations as required
- 3. When applying for a *City of Philadelphia Standard Special Hauling Permit* the following information must be provided:
 - Company & USDOT Number
 - Contact Person & Number
 - Material Being Transported

• Move Dates (see the <u>DATE & TIME RESTRICTIONS</u>)

Origin & Destination (see the <u>ROUTE RESTRICTIONS</u>)
 Travel Route (see the <u>ROUTE RESTRICTIONS</u>)

• Licenses & Registrations

Dimensions (see the <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>)
 Loads (see the <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>)

- 4. To apply for a City of Philadelphia Standard Special Hauling Permit:
 - a. visit https://www.phila.gov/departments/department-of-streets/.
 - b. click the blue "Design & construction" link.
 - c. scroll down to the section entitled "Services", then click the "Get a hauling permit" link.
 - d. click the "Department of Streets's online portal" link.
 - e. register or login to the site.
 - f. click the link entitled, "New Application", from the top or bottom menu.
 - g. complete the form. (see the <u>Sample Permit</u> for a correctly completed application example)
 - h. finalize payment with ePay.
 - i. check for email confirmations.

The status of an application may be verified on the website. An email confirmation will be sent out whenever an application is submitted, waiting, approved, revised, or rejected.

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5. When applying for a *City of Philadelphia Super Load Special Hauling Permit* the following information must be provided in addition to that of the Standard Permit:

- PennDOT State Permit Number
- If the route includes <u>no</u> bridges or <u>only</u> bridges owned and maintained by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or others, then the applicant is required to provide a Certificate of Insurance evidencing General Liability and Auto Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$2,000,000 per occurrence, <u>naming the City of Philadelphia as an Additional Insured with respect to both the General Liability and Auto Liability policies.</u>
- If the route includes <u>any</u> bridges owned and maintained by the City of Philadelphia, then the applicant is required to provide a Certificate of Insurance evidencing General Liability and Auto Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$5,000,000 per occurrence, <u>naming the City of Philadelphia as an Additional Insured with respect to both the General Liability and Auto Liability policies.</u>
- The minimum limit requirement may be satisfied with the applicant's primary policies combined with an Umbrella/Excess Liability policy.
- The correct name and address of the Certificate Holder and Additional Insured are:

If the applicant does not know which amount of insurance is required for their move, then the information will be provided by the City of Philadelphia.

6. To apply for a City of Philadelphia Super Load Special Hauling Permit:

- a. download the Super Load City Approval (SLCA) Application.
- b. complete the form and email to Hauling.Permits@phila.gov for the City of Philadelphia to review (an approved SLCA document is required in order to obtain a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit).
- c. obtain a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit by calling (610) 205-6786 or visit https://apras.penndot.gov/.
- d. email the approved Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Special Hauling Permit to Hauling.Permits@phila.gov for the City of Philadelphia to verify (do not proceed with the next step until this step is completed).
- e. visit https://www.phila.gov/departments/department-of-streets/.
- f. click the blue "Design & construction" link.
- g. scroll down to the section entitled "Services", then click the "Get a hauling permit" link.
- h. click the "Department of Streets's online portal" link.
- i. register or login to the site.
- j. click the link entitled, "New Application", from the top menu.
- k. complete the form. (see the Sample Permit for a correctly completed application example)
- 1. finalize payment with ePay.
- m. check for email confirmations.

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The status of an application may be verified on the website. An email confirmation will be sent out whenever an application is submitted, waiting, approved, revised, or rejected.

7. Numerous and flagrant code violations or attempts to subvert the system may result in hauling permit denial, account suspension, and/or legal action.

DATE & TIME RESTRICTIONS

1. Permits are typically issued for five (5) consecutive business days.

2. All moves may be made legally:

- Monday through Friday:
 - o from 10:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m.
 - o from 7:00 p.m. through 7:00 a.m.
- Saturday:
 - o from 10:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m.
- Saturday night and Sunday:
 - o only with a Police Escort and advance notification, if justification can be shown why a proposed move cannot be made during normal operating hours.

Super Load moves may be restricted to the night time slots or Saturdays, especially when traveling through Center City.

3. No moves may be made legally on:

• observed holidays in the calendar year of 2022, including but not limited to:

o Memorial Day Weekend, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on M	•
o Independence Day, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on J	• '
O Labor Day Weekend, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on S	1
O Thanksgiving Day, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on N	·
O Christmas Day, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on I	*
o New Year's Day, from 12:00 p.m. on through sunrise on J	,

- snow days.
- other emergency days.

The <u>Holiday Travel Restrictions</u> are set each year by PennDOT, usually starting at 12:00 p.m. the day before the holiday and ending at sunrise the day after the holiday.

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4.	Only moves requiring a Police Escort may not legally be made on a Fallen Police
	Officer Funeral Procession day.

ROUTE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Both the Origin and Destination of a travel route must be a street address, an intersection of two streets, or the point on a street at the location where it crosses the Philadelphia city limits.
- 2. All streets listed as part of a travel route must be inside the Philadelphia city limits. All streets that are outside the Philadelphia city limits do not fall under the city's jurisdiction and therefore will be omitted from an approved route.
- 3. All streets listed as part of a travel route must be identified by the actual streets name as designated by the City of Philadelphia and <u>not</u> a state route number. The state routes designated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania may coincide with multiple city streets and therefore do not provide sufficient information. Only interstate highways may be identified by numbers.
- 4. A SEPTA Permit is required when traveling over the subway lines on:
 - Market Street:
 - \circ from 2^{nd} Street through 22^{nd} Street with a GVW over 80,000 pounds.
 - o from 22nd Street through 44th Street with a GVW over 100,000 pounds.
 - Broad Street:
 - o from north of Pattison Avenue through Grange Avenue with a GVW over 100,000 pounds.

The City of Philadelphia will <u>not</u> approve any permit for a vehicle that is traveling over the subways lines while weighing more than the specified load limits without written authorization from SEPTA. To apply for and obtain a SEPTA Permit, <u>click here</u>.

- 5. A Park Permit is required when traveling through the city parks, including but not limited to:
 - Cobb's Creek Park
 - Fairmount Park
 - FDR Park
 - Hunting Park
 - Juniata Park
 - Pennypack Park
 - Tacony Park
 - Wissahickon Park

The City of Philadelphia will <u>not</u> approve any permit for a vehicle that is traveling on a drive through one or more of the specified city parks without written authorization from Philadelphia Parks & Recreation. To apply for and obtain a Park Permit, <u>click</u> <u>here</u>.

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- 6. A Broad-Ridge Spur Subway crossing approval is required when traveling over the subway lines on:
 - Ridge Avenue:
 - o from Broad Street through Arch Street with a GVW over 200,000 pounds and/or axles weighing over 35,000 pounds.
 - 8th Street:
 - o from Market Street through Arch Street with a GVW over 200,000 pounds and/or axles weighing over 35,000 pounds.

The City of Philadelphia will <u>not</u> approve any permit for a vehicle that is traveling over the subways lines while weighing more than the specified load limits without written authorization from the Department of Public Property and/or SEPTA. To apply for and obtain an approval, see the <u>CONTACT LIST</u>.

- 7. A PATCO Subway crossing approval is required when traveling over the subway lines on:
 - Locust Street:
 - o from 16th Street through 8th Street with a GVW over 200,000 pounds and/or axles weighing over 35,000 pounds.

The City of Philadelphia will <u>not</u> approve any permit for a vehicle that is traveling over the subways lines while weighing more than the specified load limits without written authorization from the Department of Public Property and/or PATCO. To apply for and obtain an approval, see the <u>CONTACT LIST</u>.

8. A Sensitive Bridge & Low Clearance Watch List is posted on the Bulletin Board.

SEPTA PERMIT

1. If you must travel over a subway line with a vehicle weighing more than the load limits specified in the <u>ROUTE RESTRICTIONS</u>, you must apply for and obtain an additional permit from the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA) before your Special Hauling Permit may be approved.

2. To apply for a permit:

- a. download the <u>Application for a Heavy Load Movement over Subway and Railroad</u> Tunnels.
- b. complete the form.
- c. send the form via email to <u>LoadMovement@septa.org</u>.

All SEPTA applications will be analyzed within <u>five (5) full business days</u> of submission; please plan accordingly.

3. For additional information, see the CONTACT LIST.

NOTE: For any issues that arise related to raising overhead trolley catenary wires that are in the way of making a move, call (215) 580-8616 to be dispatched to the appropriate agent.

PARK PERMIT

- If you must travel on a drive through a city park as specified in the <u>ROUTE</u>
 <u>RESTRICTIONS</u>, you must apply for and obtain an additional permit from
 Philadelphia Parks & Recreation before your Special Hauling Permit may be approved.
- 2. To apply for a permit:
 - a. download the Philadelphia Parks & Recreation Application for Permit.
 - b. complete the form.
 - c. send the form via email to Roger. Tenant Jr@phila.gov.

All Philadelphia Parks & Recreation applications will be analyzed within <u>five (5) full business days</u> of submission; please plan accordingly.

3. For additional information, see the CONTACT LIST.

NOTE: For any issues that arise related to street trees having branches that are in the way of making a move, call 911 for a non-emergency dispatch to the appropriate Parks & Recreation District Representative, and explain the particular situation.

Parks and Recreation PERMITEE (INCLUDING SUBCONTRACTORS) INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Permittee shall procure and maintain and shall cause its subcontractors to procure and maintain, at their sole cost and expense insurance of the types and minimum limits of coverage specified below for the length of time of the Permit. All insurance shall be procured from reputable insurers admitted to do business on a direct basis in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or otherwise acceptable to the City. All insurance herein, except the Professional Liability insurance, shall be written on an "occurrence" basis and not a "claims-made" basis. In no event shall Permittee exercise any rights under the Permit until the required evidence of insurance has been furnished. The City of Philadelphia and its officers, employees and agents, shall be named as additional insureds on the General Liability policy required hereunder. Such policy shall have an endorsement stating that the coverage afforded the additional insureds will be primary to any other coverage available to them.

1. Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability

- a. Workers Compensation Statutory Limits;
- Employers Liability:
 \$100,000 Each Accident Bodily Injury by Accident;
 \$100,000 Each Employee Bodily Injury by Disease;
 \$500,000 Policy limit Bodily Injury by Disease;
- c. Other states endorsement including Pennsylvania.

2. General Liability Insurance

- a. Limit of Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury (including death) and property damage liability; \$1,000,000 personal and advertising injury; \$2,000,000 general aggregate and \$1,000,000 for products and completed operations.
- b. Coverage: Premises operations; blanket contractual liability; personal injury liability; products and completed operations; independent contractors as additional insureds; employees and volunteers as Insureds; cross liability; and broad form property damage (including completed operations) liability; and explosion, collapse and underground hazards.

3. Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance

- a. Limit of Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage liability;
- b. Coverage: Owned, hired and non-owned vehicles.
- 4. Professional Liability Insurance (Required of any Permittee completing boring work)

- a. Limit of Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence
- b. Coverage: Errors and Omissions;
- c.
