



Transportation Safety Projects

There are several transportation projects planned for the Parkside and Wynnefield areas in the coming years. These projects include traffic calming, new features for people walking, biking, and taking transit, and new walkways and trails. Some will be in construction as early as this fall!



Projects Underway Include:

- Intersection improvements at 52nd and 50th & Parkside
- 2. Walking path along Parkside from 53rd Street to Bryn Mawr
- 3. Traffic light at 50th & Parkside
- 4. Gateway signs and lighting at 52nd Street under the train bridge
- 5. Bus boarding islands along Parkside
- 6. Trail connecting to the Crynwyd Trail
