STREETERY LICENSE POSTING NOTICE INFORMATION SHEET

This posting notice is required for <u>new</u> and <u>renewal</u> applications for a Streetery License.

Instructions for posting:

- This notice must be printed on an 8.5" x 11" size sheet.
- The notice must be posted in a conspicuous location in a front-facing window or door on all street facing sides of the building at the proposed licensed location.
- The notice must be posted between ten (10) and thirty (30) days prior to filing an application and must remain in-place until a license is approved or denied.
 - Upload a copy of the time-stamped photos showing proof of posting on the building.
- No license application will be approved without proof of posting.
- Failure to post sign for the minimum ten (10) day period will result in a delay in license issuance or renewal.
- The notice must be in good condition and protected from weather.
