### PART C

#### Limits and Conditions

- Annual hot work license is issued for the business-related activity on site.
- Welding, cutting, open torches and other hot work operations and equipment shall comply with Chapter 35 of the Philadelphia Fire Code.
- Compressed gas cylinders and fuel containers shall comply with this chapter and chapter 53.
- An oxygen-fuel gas system with two or more manifolded cylinders of oxygen shall be in accordance with NFPA 51.
- Hot work shall only be conducted in areas designed or authorized for that purpose by the personnel responsible for a Hot Work Program.
- Hot work shall not be conducted in the following areas unless approval has been obtained from the fire code official:
  1. Areas where the sprinkler system is impaired.
  2. Areas where there exists the potential of an explosive atmosphere, such as locations where flammable gases, liquids or vapors are present.
  3. Areas with readily ignitable materials, such as storage of large quantities of bulk sulfur, baled paper, cotton, lint, dust, or loose combustible materials.
  4. On board ships at dock or ships under construction or repair.
  5. At other locations as specified by the fire code official
- A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 2-A:20-B:C rating shall be readily accessible within 30 feet of the location where hot work is performed.
- Visible hazard identification signs shall be provided where the hot work area is open to persons other than the operator of the hot work equipment, conspicuous signs shall be posted to warn others before they enter the hot work area. Such signs shall display the following warning. CAUTION - HOTWORK IN PROGRESS - STAY CLEAR
