**PART C
Limits and Conditions**

C

1. The storage of tires and tire by products on sidewalks (right of ways) or streets is prohibited;
2. The storage or display of tires and tire byproducts outdoors is prohibited unless otherwise approved by the Department and compliant with Section 3405 of the Philadelphia Fire Code;
Note: Display piles not exceeding 6 feet in height and limited to a single column or row are permitted, provided that pile is stable and provides for drainage to prevent the accumulation of water.
3. Indoor storage of tires and tire byproducts shall not exceed 6 feet in height unless otherwise approved by the Department through the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.
4. Storage of tires shall ensure all the following dimensional requirements are met (PFC 3409.1):
 - a. Storage of tires does not exceed 50 feet in length or width.
 - b. Where tire storage is adjacent or along one wall, storage of tires does not exceed 25 feet.
5. Storage shall be kept neat and orderly with clear aisles and access to all exits. Minimum clear aisle widths of 36 inches must be maintained for public access and 28 inches for non-public access.
6. Signage prohibiting SMOKING and OPEN BURNING in and around the tire storage areas shall be posted in conspicuous locations (PFC 3404)
7. Fire extinguishers shall be maintained in accordance with IFC Section 906 (PFC 3408.2)
8. Tire buffing operations, when within the same facility, shall be located within a room separated from the remainder of the building by 1-hr fire resistance rated assemblies. (PFC 3403.2)
9. Tire manifest must be maintained on-site and be made available to the Department upon request.
10. Current certifications for all fire protection systems shall be submitted.
11. Failure to comply with these provisions, the requirements of the Philadelphia Code, and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and of the United States may result in suspension or revocation of the Tire Dealer License.
