

## ***Dear Philly Candidates,***

**Don't forget** that City employees have restrictions on political activity and gifts! **Please** help them stay on the right side of the law by **NOT** asking them to:



- **raise money** for your campaign or **help with campaign fundraising events**
- **do paid or volunteer** work for your campaign, including canvassing and get-out-the vote (except City Council Staff)
- **forward** or share campaign related emails and materials, even if those materials do not ask for contributions
- **appear** in your campaign ads, mailers, or other materials
- **accept gifts** if you are seeking official action from them
- **speak at campaign events**, whether or not they involve fundraising
- **treat you differently** than other members of the public because you are a candidate
- **use their official title** when expressing their support for you (or opposition to another candidate)
- **serve as a party official**, such as a ward leader or committee person
- **serve as a member of an election board**, whether appointed or elected
- engage in **any** political activity while they are **on duty, in uniform, in their City workplace, using City resources, or using their City title or status**
