The sustainable business tax credit allows businesses certified as sustainable to receive a tax credit of up to \$4,000 on the Business Income & Receipts Tax (BIRT). Fill out this application to determine your eligibility for the tax credit on your 2022 BIRT return. This application must be received by April 15, 2023.
