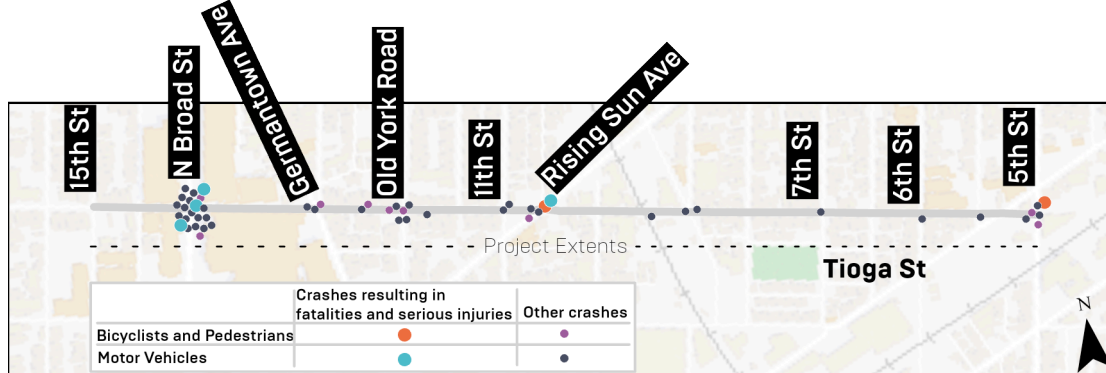


## ABOUT THE PROJECT

### WHAT IS GREAT STREETS PHL?

Great Streets PHL is part of the City's Vision Zero strategy which aims to eliminate all traffic-related deaths and severe injuries, and increase safety, health, & mobility. Funded by a federal RAISE grant for both design and construction.

### WHAT WILL GREAT STREETS PHL DO?

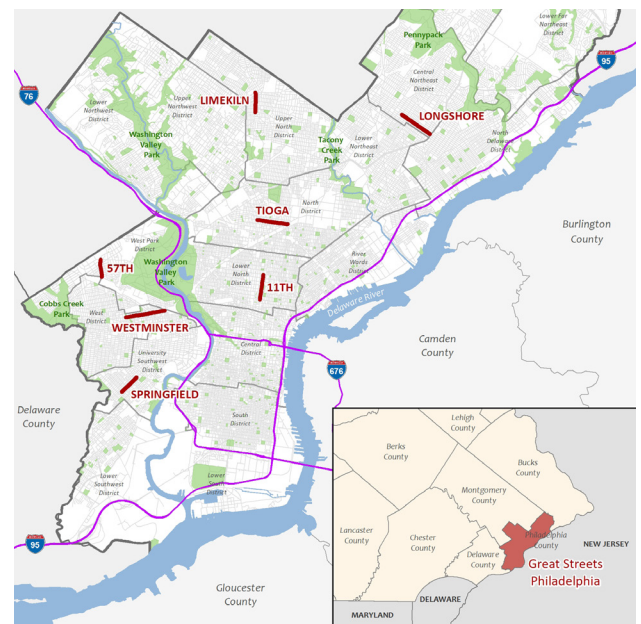
**IMPROVE SAFETY:** Each of the streets included in this project are on the High Injury Network where the greatest concentration of traffic-related deaths and injuries occur. Improvements to the street design will make streets safer and more welcoming for people using all modes of travel.

**COLLABORATE:** Collaborate with residents and neighbors to get input on the traffic safety issues and what improvement types are wanted and needed.

**REPAIR & REFRESH STREETS:** Bring streets up to a "state of good repair" that includes repaving roads, fixing potholes, re-striping, signal upgrades, and standard safety improvements like ADA-accessible ramps at crossings.

**CREATE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES:** Create connections to job training and resources that will enable local workers to benefit from job opportunities associated with project construction.

### WHAT IS VISION ZERO?

Vision Zero (VZ) is a policy that says traffic deaths are preventable & unacceptable. Human life is prioritized over moving vehicles, because people are more vulnerable on the street. Principles like equity, safe streets and safe speeds are essential.

### CRASHES IN THE PROJECT AREA



There were **52 crashes** on W Tioga St between 2017 and 2021. **20** crashes were angled at intersections, **11** were rear-ends, and **10** involved pedestrians.

### DEATHS & INJURIES



**3** people died and **46** people were injured (with **5** serious injuries) in crashes on W Tioga St between 2017 and 2021.
