




You Must Act to Keep Your Coverage

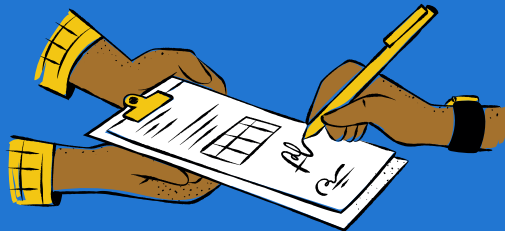
Medicaid and CHIP are now again requiring individuals to renew yearly benefits and demonstrate they meet income requirements. Your renewal application is due the month before your coverage expires. If you are no longer eligible for Medicaid, the state also offers free and low-cost health insurance options at www.pennie.com or chipcoverspakids.com if you have kids under age 19.
