We are writing to request time on the Art Commission agenda for Wednesday, September 13, for Concept Approval for improvements to the courtyard at Wynnefield Library, 5325 Overbrook Avenue. These improvements are a part of the City of Philadelphia's Rebuild initiative.

Wynnefield Library is a Free Library of Philadelphia site located in the Wynnefield neighborhood of northwest Philadelphia at the intersection of 54th Street and Overbrook Avenue. The scope of this project is limited to upgrades to the courtyard located between the library and the adjacent John C. Anderson Cultural Center.

The current construction budget is approximately \$286,000. Proposed upgrades include new seating areas, partial wall replacement, the addition of emergency egress gates, new landscaping, new hardscaping, and renovations to make the courtyard entrance ADA accessible.







Amphitheater that could be used for a variety of things. Solar lighting, lighting for evening programming.










