Limits and Conditions

Motor Vehicle Repair

• No person who owns, operates or controls or who is employed in the business of repairing motor vehicles shall use any portion of City sidewalks or streets for the repair of motor vehicles.

Public Parking Lots / Garages

- No person shall conduct, operate or maintain a public parking lot or public garage without obtaining a license from the L&I.
- Each licensee shall provide a distinctive badge, cap, shirt or uniform for the use of his employees, which shall bear the
 name of the parking lot and a number to be assigned to each employee and shall be worn by each employee while on
 duty.
- No licensee shall permit any person not employed at a parking lot to loiter in and about such garage.

Drainage for paved areas larger than 5000 square feet is provided.

Lights that allow safe access to the licensed area after dark is provided.

- Every public garage shall be equipped with fire extinguishing apparatus of such type and in such quantity as shall be approved by the Fire Department.
- Each licensee shall be liable for any damage to or theft of any motor vehicle accepted for parking, and for the bodily injury
 to any individual, which shall occur as the result of the negligence of the licensee or of any of his employees.
- Any person who violates subsection 9-601(2)(d) shall have committed a Class II offense and be subject to the fines set forth in the Philadelphia Code.
- No person shall offer to provide or provide the service of valet parking unless the person has insurance in an amount
 determined by the Office of Risk Management in the areas of liability insurance, theft and property insurance, and worker's
 compensation insurance.
