48th St between Market St and Kingsessing Ave & 47th St between Paschall Ave and Chestnut St

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE PROJECT?

- Find out which traffic safety issues are important to the community and where issues occur along 47th & 48th Streets
- Improve safety for vulnerable users on both streets
- Add traffic calming elements to encourage safe driving
- Improve and connect the High Quality Bicycle Network through West Philadelphia with a new north-south corridor
- Maintain driver access to residences and businesses

WHY NOW?

The repaving of 48th St is an opportunity to change the layout of the streets and improve traffic safety for all users. Before any changes are made, City staff needs your input.





Crash on 48th Street, August 2023



Between 2018 and 2022, 298 crashes were reported on 48th & 47th; 56 people were seriously injured and 1 person was killed. 46 of those crashes involved people walking and 18 involved people biking.
