

Dear Philadelphia schools staff,

To demonstrate <u>Affordable Connectivity Program</u> qualification under the <u>Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch or School Breakfast criterion</u>, **families will need to upload a completed version of the below letter template**. <u>Families should use this letter if their child receives free/reduced-price lunch or breakfast, regardless of which school they attend.</u>

To be accepted in the ACP application, letters must include the following:

- School letterhead
- Mail merged (ideally; otherwise typed) student, school, and guardian name
- School contact information

We have seen letters with hand-written entries rejected in the past, so the above recommendations ensure families' applications will be accepted.

Important note: there are other ways families can demonstrate eligibility that do not include a document upload. For example, if a family participates in SNAP and enters their Social Security Number in their ACP application, they will oftentimes receive an automatic qualification in the portal.

[School Name] would like to make you aware of the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), the Federal Communications Commission's program that can help families keep their internet.

Eligible households can receive:

- A discount of up to \$30 per month towards broadband service; and
- A discount of up to \$100 to buy a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers. A household must contribute between \$10 and \$50 toward the device cost.

Internet access has become an important part of fully participating in school and we want to make sure [student's name] has reliable, affordable access at home. Because your student(s) participates in a free or reduced-price meal initiative under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or the School Breakfast Program (SBP), your household is <u>automatically eligible</u> to receive the ACP benefit.

As a part of the ACP application process, you will need to provide identification and eligibility documentation. This letter, which can be used to prove eligibility during the application process, confirms that the following student(s) in your household participates in a school meal program during the 2023 - 2024 school year:
