  - i. Item in Accord with Previous Policy
    - i. Zoning Bill No. 230132: Amending Chapter 14-600 of The Philadelphia Code ("Use Regulations") to clarify that the sale of marijuana for recreational use is not included in the Medical Marijuana Dispensary use category, under certain terms and conditions. Introduced by Councilmembers Jones and O'Neill on February 23, 2023.

Council wishes to restrict marijuana dispensaries to only medical use amidst rumored discussions in the General Assembly of possibly allowing recreational marijuana to be distributed in the Commonwealth

In 2016, Council added a definition to the Zoning Code for medical marijuana dispensaries, with Bill No. 160919. This bill established a medical marijuana dispensary as "A person who holds a permit issued by the Department of Health of the Commonwealth pursuant to the Act of April 17, 2016, P.L. 84, No. 16, to dispense medical marijuana." The Commission recommended approval of that bill.

This Bill adds language prohibiting recreational marijuana. Since recreational marijuana is already illegal, Philadelphia's Code will still comply with Pennsylvania statues.

Staff notes, however, that despite legalization of marijuana sales and distribution in Pennsylvania and other states, marijuana is still regulated solely by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency. As such, it remains illegal everywhere in the United States.

Staff recommendation is for approval.

2. Action Item: Zoning Bill No. 230107: To amend the Philadelphia Zoning Maps by changing the zoning designations of certain areas of land located within an area bounded by 63rd Street, Callowhill Street, Felton Street and Vine Street. Introduced by Councilmember Jones on February 16, 2023. (Presented by Brian Wenrich)

This remapping was requested by Boy's Latin of Philadelphia Charter School for the purpose of implementing SP-CIV Civic, Educational, and Medical zoning for the school campus at 63rd Street.

Staff recommendation is for approval.

Chair Fadullon noted for the record that it was one of the first rezoning the Commission had seen to properly map the schools that are in residential districts (00:06:06).

Questions and comments from the Commission (00:06:21).

Commissioner Valle inquired about the vision for a greater initiative and effort.

Seeing no further questions and comments from the Commission, Chair Fadullon asked for a motion at the minute mark in video (00:08:03).

Motion duly made by Commissioner Syrnick and seconded by Commissioner Summerville to approve staff recommendation for approval.

Action Item: Streets Bill No. 230128: Authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 125 by placing on the City Plan Boston Place from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street, north of York Street, under certain terms and conditions, including the dedication to the City of the bed of said Boston Place. Introduced by Councilmember Jones on behalf of Council President Clarke on February 23, 2023. (Presented by Daniel Farrell)

PHA requested an amendment to the City Plan to place Boston Place from N 10th Street to N 11th Street, north of York Street. PHA is redeveloping the PHA Fairhill superblock. The new street would break up the superblock and reconnect the street grid. This would create a new northern and southern block for the PHA Fairhill site. Staff recommendation is for approval.

Questions and comments from the Commission (00:11:03).

Commissioner Capita, Commissioner Johns, and Chair Fadullon commended the project.
