


Intercity Bus Loading Relocation – The City of Philadelphia will be temporarily relocating passenger loading and drop off operations for four interstate bus companies to Spring Garden Street and Columbus Boulevard on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The four companies are Flix, Greyhound, CoachUSA (Megabus), and Peter Pan. Peter Pan service may be available starting November 10<sup>th</sup> (please check with this provider for details).

## **Description of Activities by Location**

- (A) Starting on November 10, 2023, loading will be permitted on the south curb of Spring Garden Street on either
- (B) Starting November 16, 2023, loading will be permitted along 300 feet south of Spring Garden Street.
- (C) Between November 16, 2023 and November 30<sup>th</sup> CoachUSA/Megabus will conduct loading operations along the north curb in the existing bus loading area adjacent to the SEPTA Spring Garden Station Exit.
- (D) On Thanksgiving week, Noble Street will be cleared of parking, paved and bus layover, and spill over loading will be permitted on the edge of the public right of way.
