



No.	Issue	Roundabout Option	Upgraded Signalized Intersection Option
1	Current intersection layout encourages speeding	Sharp angles entering into the roundabout discourage speeding.	Striping and curb line changes up to and within intersection to encourage lower speeds.
2	Need more time for pedestrians (particularly seniors) to cross the street	Pedestrians will use refuge areas (splitter islands) and reduce crossing distances.	Reduce crossing distances and increase amount of time allocated for pedestrians to cross.
3	Improve pedestrian signage	Vehicular warning signage for pedestrians will be added at each crossing.	Vehicular warning signage for pedestrians will be added at each crossing.
4	Reduce pedestrian and bicycle conflict points	Pedestrians and bicyclists will use shared use facilities.	Pedestrians will use sidewalk (shared use path), bicyclists will use designated bike lanes that are next to vehicular traffic.
5	Traffic signals need to be more visible	Traffic signals will be removed.	Traffic signals will be located to increase visibility.
6	Improve lighting at intersection	Improved lighting is a part of this project.	Improved lighting is a part of this project.















Parkside Avenue and N 53rd Street Intersection



No.	Issue	Roundabout Option	Upgraded Signalized Intersection Option
1	High crash intersection including near misses with pedestrians	Roundabouts are a proven safety countermeasure to reduce crashes. Vehicular warning signage for pedestrians will be added at each crossing.	Pedestrian assistance features such as APS (Accessible Pedestrian Signal) will be added at each crossing.
2	More crosswalks are needed	Crosswalks and access to Parkside Evans Playground will be improved.	Crosswalks and access to Parkside Evans Playground will be improved.
3	Reduce the distance for pedestrian crossings, including to/from Parkside Evans Playground	Pedestrians will use refuge areas (splitter islands) and reduce crossing distances.	Reduce crossing distances and increase pedestrian crossing time due to Parkside Evans Playground proximity.
4	Current intersection layout encourages speeding, especially right turns heading North on Parkside	Sharp angles entering into the roundabout discourage speeding.	Striping and curb line changes up to and within intersection to encourage lower speeds.
5	Left-turn movements at this intersection are dangerous	Left-turn movements, which result in high-speed angle collisions, will be eliminated.	Left-turn phase will be added with revised signal timing.
6	Improve visibility of traffic signals at intersection. Current location within the intersection is poor.	Traffic signals will be removed.	Traffic signals will be located to increase visibility.
7	Improve lighting at intersection	Improved lighting is a part of this project.	Improved lighting is a part of this project.
8	Improve drainage at intersection	Improved drainage is a part of this project.	Improved drainage is a part of this project.
