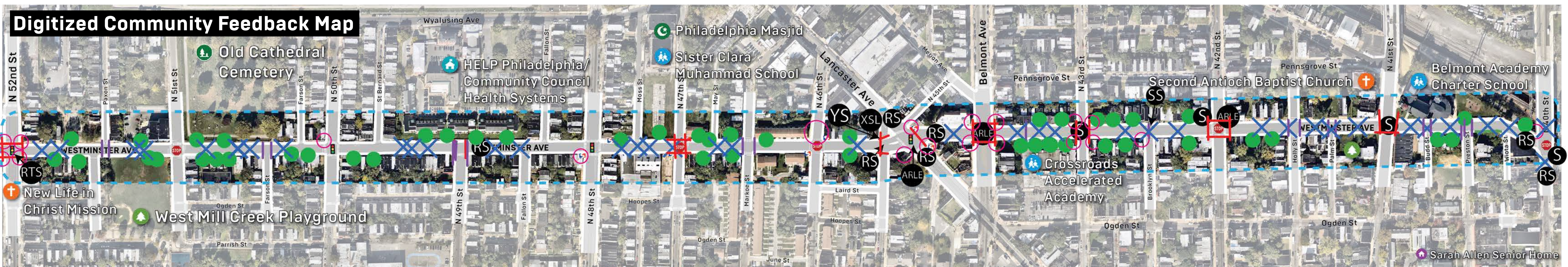
Great Streets PHL Round 1 Meeting and Pop-Up

Feedback Themes & Top Areas of Concern

- 52nd St intersection feels very dangerous
- Speeding is a top issue on the corridor
- Lancaster and 45th St intersection feels complicated and dangerous
- Walking and driving at Belmont Ave feels unsafe

-  Speed cushions/speed humps
-  New Tree (coordination with property owner needed)
-  Corner bump outs
-  Raised crosswalk
-  Mid-block Crossing
