
We respectfully request administrative approval for improvements at Carroll Park. This PPR site is located at 5801 West Girard Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19131.

The following brief describes the extent of work:


Carroll Park is currently in design for proposed minor improvements that will improve the safety and usability of the park; the park went through extensive renovations in 2018 which included a new playground, sprayground, new hardscape and site furniture. The current proposal will build on that work by expanding the playground to include a new swingset with four belt swings and the replacement of a missing playground spinner, swings, and benches. Other improvements include replacing the wood and painting of 32 benches throughout the park, a new lockable bulletin board to display community events and new signs at park entrances. Capital Projects is overseeing the community engagement, design, and projected installation of new play equipment, safety surface and site furnishings. The existing trees and vegetation on site will remain and be protected. Please see the next pages for existing photos, an aerial, and playground layout plan for your understanding of the site and scope.

The Project budget is \$182,000.




EXISTING SITE CONDITIONS

















