### **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The McVeigh Rebuild project is a \$15M investment and was designed through community engagement and conversations with city stakeholders.

The new McVeigh Recreation Center will include:

- All-new Recreation Center Building and Gym
- New Playgrounds
- · Keeping the pool where it is

We anticipate that upgrades to other site elements, such as sport courts and ball fields, will require more funds. We are committed to looking for these additional funds. Stay tuned for more updates in upcoming community meetings.

An environmental assessment conducted earlier this year found that areas of the site need of remediation. To ensure public health and safety, funds were redirected to address this as the first phase of site work and before new construction begins. When required, remediation is a standard part of all Rebuild projects across the city.

### **Coming up Next:**

- Winter 2023-24: Environmental remediation and demolition of the existing building
- **Spring 2024:** Construction of the new building and playgrounds is anticipated to begin
