Re: Periodic Certification of Fire Protection Systems

## Dear Building Owner/ Manager:

You are receiving this notice because City of Philadelphia records indicate that your building is serviced by fire protection systems subject to periodic testing and inspection requirements under the Philadelphia Fire Code.

The following systems are subject to testing and inspection requirements:

- Fire sprinklers
- Fire alarms
- Emergency and standby power
- Smoke Control Systems
- Dampers in high-rise buildings and certain occupancies providing social entertainment
- Other fire suppression systems, including protections for kitchen hoods, spray booths, or electrical equipment.

These inspections must be made by a qualified individual licensed by the City and certification must be provided using City forms. Visit the City's website, <a href="www.phila.gov/li/fire-protection-certification">www.phila.gov/li/fire-protection-certification</a>, for more information on required certifications. Please note that systems servicing buildings used solely for 1-2 dwelling units are not subject to these certification requirements. Homeowners must refer to their operational manuals for maintenance requirements of systems serving their homes.

Beginning April 1, 2023, all certifications were to be submitted to the City by the licensed inspector through <a href="http://eclipse.phila.gov">http://eclipse.phila.gov</a>. Building owners and licensed inspectors may be subject to enforcement action if required certifications are not submitted by <a href="May 31, 2024">May 31, 2024</a>.

You may verify that certifications have been successfully submitted to the City through <a href="www.atlas.phila.gov">www.atlas.phila.gov</a>. Search for your property address and click on the Licenses and Inspections tab to find all Building Certifications submitted for the property.

If your building is no longer serviced by a fire protection system, please contact the Department at <a href="https://form.jotform.com/PhillyLI/FSDiscontinue">https://form.jotform.com/PhillyLI/FSDiscontinue</a> by May 31, 2024. Additional information demonstrating that the building remains in compliance with the Philadelphia Code may be required.
