
Citizens Police Oversight Commission


CPOC currently:

- Audits and monitors Internal Affairs investigations and police disciplinary processes
- Conducts oversight of police shootings
- Analyzes police data
- Develops policy recommendations and reports
- Engages in outreach and training




Complaint Data: Demographics

In the month of March 2024, CPOC referred 12 complaints to PPD's Internal Affairs Division (IAD). CPOC has referred a total of 39 complaints so far in 2024.

Race Distribution Gender Distribution





Complaint Data: Allegations

About a third of the allegations reported by complainants in 2024 to date are related to Departmental Violations.


A single complaint can have multiple misconduct allegations.

Auditing & Monitoring Unit

The Auditing unit is continuing to conduct regular audits of Complaints Against Police (CAPS).

The first auditing report is complete! It covers the foundational work of the unit:

- Auditing manual details how CPOC audits completed CAPs
- Auditing analysis presents our findings on CAPs received between March and June 2022.
- After this, more up to date findings on audits will be released more regularly.

The unit also continues its Body Worn Camera (BWC) work.

 New staff have access to videos and will begin helping with the BWC audit project this week.

Auditing & Monitoring Unit (continued)

New project: reviewing use of force investigations at IAD

- Project is in early stages
- We will provide updates as development continues

CPOC monitors IAD investigations currently, but the unit recently submitted a draft model policy to PPD to formalize the process.

We will continue to develop this program collaboratively so that it is feasible and impactful for all.

In the meantime, the unit is monitoring 7 cases at IAD. The goal is to be able to report on our observations of interviews at IAD to shed more light on IAD investigations.

Investigation Unit: Police Shootings (March 2024)

There were no police shootings in the month of March 2024. In 2024 so far, there have been 3 police shootings. This total includes every time a PPD officer(s) discharges their firearm at a person.

Accidental discharges, animal shootings, and officer suicides are not included.

Policy Unit

The Policy Unit continued working on all open projects and data reporting.

- Academy Survey Enhancement: In collaboration with the Philadelphia Police
 Academy (Captain Clark), CPOC designed a comprehensive survey to gauge recruit
 satisfaction with academy training. This survey instrument will be used to identify
 specific areas for improvement, enhancing the overall training experience for
 recruits.
- Guest Lectures at UPenn School of Social Policy and Practice: Allison Teti, Damon Green, and Taleah Grimmage recently served as guest lecturers at the UPenn School of Social Policy and Practice in the Data for Equitable Justice Lab.

Policy Unit (continued)

- Podcast Appearance on "New Roots, Femme Roots": Our team members were invited to speak on the student podcast "New Roots, Femme Roots." This podcast centers on challenges immigrant women face in our community. Their contributions helped shed light on important issues at the intersection of community, law enforcement, and social justice.
- Charging Data Analysis: CPOC recently completed a comprehensive data analysis project focusing on charging reviews for the year 2023. This analysis will be used for an upcoming report, providing valuable insights into trends and patterns related to law enforcement discipline practices.

The Outreach & Training Unit is tasked with handling incoming complaints, providing constituent services to city residents who need resources and connection with other City services, community education and training of staff, as well as engaging with the many diverse communities of our City.

We look forward to expanding our staff to make meaningful connections with underserved communities while advocating and promoting transparent and equitable policing.



Discussion topics were: The History of Oversight in Philadelphia, CPOC Role and Mission, Why


