Instructions

AIR POLLUTION LICENSE APPLICATION FOR MINOR EMISSION SOURCE

1. Air Pollution License is required for the operation of a minor emission source. Minor emission source is the source being exempted from the 25 Pa Code 127.14 or is located in a facility that has the annual emission restriction of less than:

8 tons of Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) or Sulfur oxide (SOx);

20 tons of Carbon monoxide (CO);

10 tons of Nitrogen oxide (NOx);

3 tons of particulate;

1 ton of a single Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP); or

2.5 tons of combined HAP

- The License is issued annually and expired on October 31 of each year except for the indefinite license. An indefinite license is for furnace or boiler with rated capacity of less than 5,000,000 BTU per hour using only No. 2 grade or lighter commercial fuel oil, or less than 10,000,000 BTU per hour using only natural gas.
- 3. Complete the application form and submit along with the application fee payable to the "City of Philadelphia".
