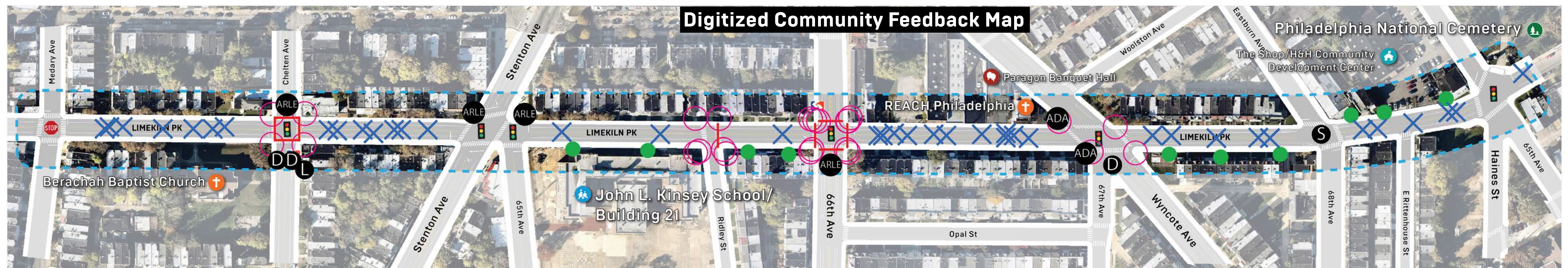


WHAT DID WE HEAR? Neighborhood feedback on Limekiln Pike from Medary Ave to Haines St

What We Heard: Community Feedback Summary

Feedback Themes & Top Areas of Concern

- Speeding is a top issue on the corridor
- Chelton Ave and Wyncote Ave are dangerous intersections
- Red light running is an issue at Stenton Ave
- There are issues with illegal parking and illegal dumping

Community Preferred Tools

1. Speed cushions/ speed humps
2. Corner bump outs
3. New Tree (coordination with property owner needed)
4. Raised crosswalk
