


TRAFFIC CRASHES ON LONGSHORE AVE FROM ROOSEVELT BLVD TO FRONTENAC ST


ZERO TRAFFIC DEATHS BY 2030



CONTRIBUTING FACTORS TO CRASHES

- People in vehicles traveling at unsafe speeds on local neighborhood streets.
- Missing or outdated crosswalks that make it harder for people walking to safely cross at intersections.
- Blocked ADA ramps making it difficult for neighbors with mobility issues (or pushing shopping carts and strollers) to get around.
- Vehicles parked too close to corners making it difficult for people driving, people walking, and people riding bikes to see each other at intersections.

CRASHES IN PROJECT AREA



There were **34 crashes** on Longshore Avenue between 2017-2021. **20** crashes were angled at intersections and **3** were rear-ends and **4** involved pedestrians.

DEATHS AND INJURIES



25 people were injured in crashes on Longshore Avenue between 2017 and 2021.
