 - Individual misconduct investigations might not be possible before 2025. However, the Investigations Unit is doing extensive investigative work outside of individual misconduct investigations.
 - Question from Commissioner Bennett: If legislation grants CPOC the power of investigation, why does the CBA matter?
 - The city ordinance does not trump the existing CBA or related contracts.
 - Question from chat asking if there are other updates for other cases, like there are for officer involved shooting database.
 - Currently police shooting updates are published, in the future after action reports, NTSB style investigations will be published.
 - We do not publish updates on individual cases.
