

Continuing the Committee on Historic Designation's discussion  
of the proposed Spruce Hill historic district, southeast quadrant

At its 17 April 2024 meeting, the Committee on Historic Designation began its review of the nomination for the proposed Spruce Hill historic district, southeast quadrant. It heard comments from property owners for approximately 40 minutes, but then adjourned the meeting upon losing its quorum. The Historical Commission should refer the nomination back to the Committee on Historic Designation for additional review at a newly added meeting on 26 June 2024. Everyone, including property owners who have not spoken and the public, will have an opportunity to participate in the review at the 26 June 2024 meeting of the Committee on Historic Designation. Note that the next meeting of the Committee on Historic Designation is scheduled for 22 May 2024, but that agenda includes the proposed Washington Square West historic district and therefore would not provide ample time to review the nomination for the large Spruce Hill historic district as well.
