Instructions

RELATIVE ACCURACY TEST AUDIT (RATA) PROTOCOL/REPORT COVER SHEET

1. You must submit this cover sheet with each RATA protocol and report. You only need one cover sheet for each RATA protocol or report, even if they cover multiple units (this is different than for stack tests).
2. Some fields to note:
 - a. Plant ID - Please list this for your facility if you know it. If you don't know it, leave this field blank.
 - b. Test Date(s) – For RATA protocols, list the estimated test date(s). We realize that tests do not always go off as planned and will not hold your facility to the exact dates. For RATA reports, list the actual test date(s).
 - c. RATA No. – For RATA reports, list the RATA No., which you can find in the RATA protocol approval letter or e-mail. AMS now assigns a RATA No. to each RATA program.
 - i. The RATA No. covers entire test, so the protocol will have the same RATA No. as the RATA report.
 - ii. The RATA No. covers all units and pollutants tested as part of the RATA program. If a facility is conducting RATAs on three boilers for NO_x and CO in this RATA program, they will all fall under the same RATA No. If RATAs are conducted on a fourth boiler later in the year, it will get a separate RATA No.
 - d. Unit(s) Tested – List the name(s) of the unit(s) tested (ex. Boiler #1).
 - e. CEM/COM(s) Tested – Pollutant – List the Continuous Emission or Opacity Monitor(s) tested for each unit by pollutant (ex. NO_x).
 - f. CEM/COM(s) Tested – ID – List the ID of the Continuous Emission or Opacity Monitor(s) tested for each unit (ex. 0111101). This is the ID listed on the quarterly CEM and COM reports submitted by facilities. It is typically the facility's five-digit Plant ID followed by two digits.
