What is a neighborhood bikeway?

- A street with low traffic volumes and speeds that is comfortable for people walking and biking
- A key part of a **low-stress** network of bicycle routes that increases road **safety for all users**
- Traffic calming treatments, signs, and pavement markings increase awareness that the road is a bicycle priority route. The **top three treatments identified by Germantown residents** as priorities are on the right.


