## What is a neighborhood bikeway?

- A street with **low traffic volumes and speeds** that is comfortable for people walking and biking
- A key part of a **low-stress** network of bicycle routes that increases road **safety for all users**
- Traffic calming treatments, signs, and pavement markings increase awareness that the road is a bicycle priority route. The **top three treatments identified by Germantown residents** as priorities are on the right.

- Summer 2023** ● Public workshop, draft route map developed
- Fall 2023** ● Online survey, feedback on route map and treatments
- WE ARE HERE Spring 2024** ● Updated route map, online survey, feedback on route map and priorities
- Summer 2024** ● Final design for priority routes, ongoing outreach, apply for construction funding

# West Germantown Neighborhood Bikeways Draft Map

## Identified Routes

Fall 2023 survey responses matched our route analysis, identifying the following streets for bikeways:

- Pulaski Ave
- Schoolhouse Ln
- Coulter St
- Harvey St
- McCallum St

## Why these routes?

Selected routes are **direct**, with **low speeds, low car volumes, and few traffic lights**.

- Evaluated Neighborhood Bikeway Route
- Future Bikeway Connection
- Existing Bicycle Lanes and Trails
- Regional Rail Lines/Stations
