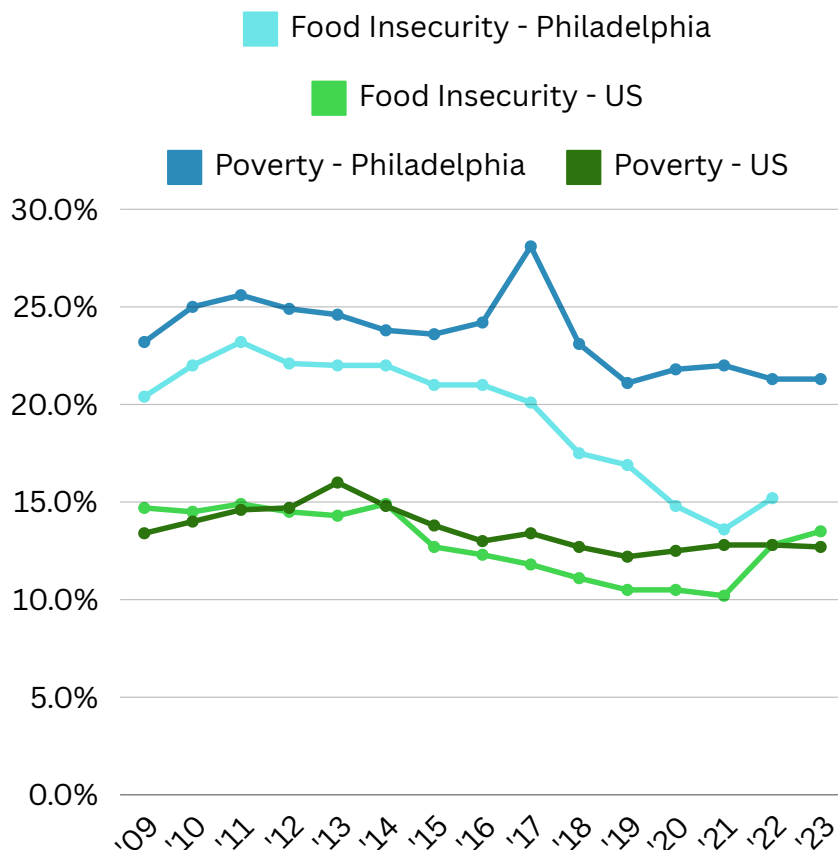

## Poverty and Food Insecurity



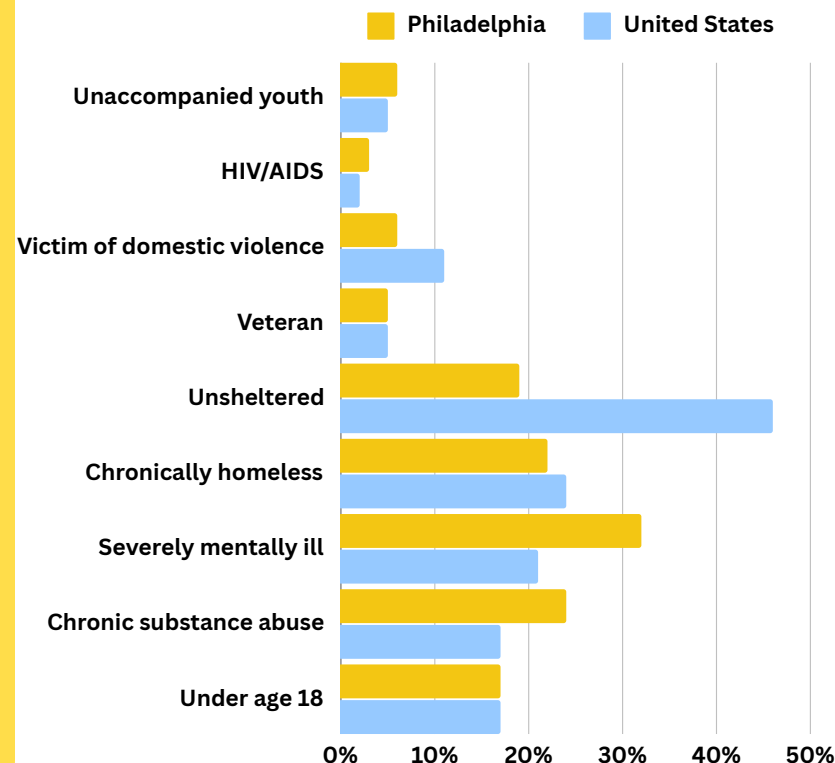

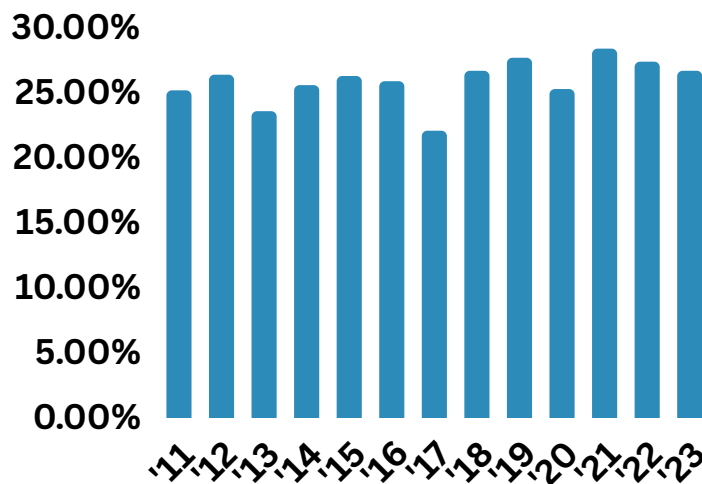

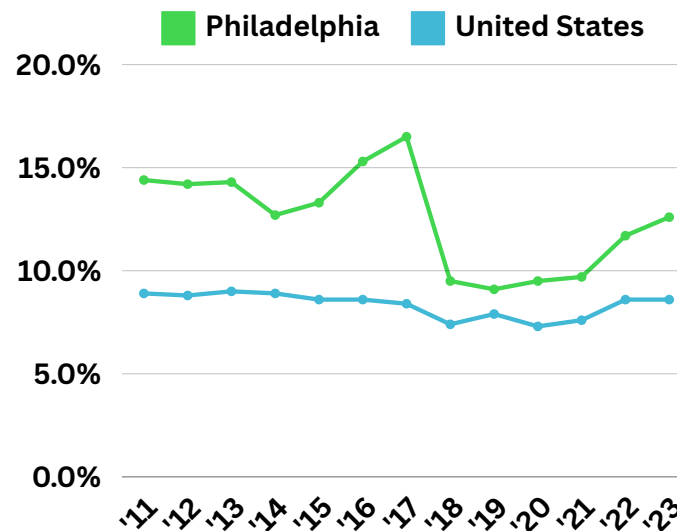

**810,680 Meals Served**

- 74% offer additional services (counseling, hygiene products, health services, etc.)
