We respectfully request administrative approval for playground improvements at Malcolm X Memorial Park located at 5100 Pine St. Philadelphia, Pa 19143.

The following brief describes the extent of work:

Capital improvements are in order for Malcolm X Memorial Park's playground and site amenities. In the same footprint as the existing playground, we plan to install new play equipment and safety surfacing. This design is done in-house, and our goal is to unify the playground layout for increased safety. All existing trees will remain and be protected in place. Additional improvements include new site furnishings.


The Project budget is \$715,000. \$550,000 is funded by Rebuild, \$100,000 is funded by a DCED grant, and \$55,000 is funded by Councilmember Gauthier.




EXISTING CONDITIONS








COMMUNITY INPUT


The community used sticker voting and an online survey to provide feedback. The most popular themes were **nature and geometric**, shaping the subsequent design choices.

Three different designs were presented to the community. The top-voted design includes a large geometric climber, a tree climber inspired by driftwood, and six swings.

The community also voted on their preferred color palette, with **Malcolm X colors (red, green, and black)** emerging as the top choice. Council also prefers these colors.











PROPOSED PLAYGROUND

PROPOSED TREE PROTECTION PLAN




