After security and the turnstiles, take the second bank of elevators to the 18th floor. After exiting an elevator, follow the signs to Conference Room 18-029, called the City Planning Commission and Historical Commission Conference Room, the same room that the Historical Commission met in before March 2020. When entering the conference room, please sign into the meeting on the sign-in sheet.
