Philadelphia Parks & Recreation (PPR) is made up over 300 neighborhood parks, recreation centers, and playgrounds as well as over 272 miles of trails. The Planning, Preservation Property Management (PPPM) provides the GIS support for all divisions of PPR.

PPPM is seeking a self-motivated and organized seasonal Recreation Specialty Instructor (RSI) to serve as a GIS Technician Intern to provide GIS technical support and assistance. Tasks will include data creation and maintenance, geostatistical queries, and data visualization through hardcopy/digital maps. The position will require attention to detail, ability to comprehend historical and legal documents for use in translating legal descriptions and will provide technical support for web maps and apps developed by the GIS team. Ideal candidates will have working knowledge of creating and editing feature geometry, updating attribute information, geocoding, and utilizing queries to filter data.

The position will have a Monday – Friday schedule. This position reports to the GIS Coordinator at Philadelphia Parks & Recreation (PPR).
