
Ivy Ridge Trail is made a priority by the new citywide Trail Master Plan.



A feasibility study is done for the Ivy Ridge Trail. Identifying four trail treatment options.


Design/Construction completed on Manayunk Bridge Trail.

Design/Construction completed on Manayunk Bridge Trail - 24 hour lighting access.




A conceptual design is completed for the Ivy Ridge Trail section between Dupont St & Canton St.

- Connection to Ivy Ridge Station provides multi-modal enhancements















Ivy Ridge Trail - 2023 Conceptual Design










