The Philadelphia Large Users Group ("PWD") hereby submits this brief letter in lieu of exceptions to the July 1, 2025, Hearing Officer's Report. PLUG generally concurs with the Hearing Officer's Report. This letter addresses only the recommendation that the Rate Board deny PLUG's proposals to reject PWD's modifications to the eligibility requirements for PWD's Charitable Discount program on grounds the proposed Charity Rate Regulations do not alter rates. See Hearing Officer Report at 42. As detailed in PLUG's Main and Reply Briefs, the proposed eligibility changes for the Charity Rate discount impact rates because the revenue proposals presented by PWD in the rate proceeding assume eligible customers receive the Charity Rate discount. See PLUG Main Brief at 8, see PLUG Reply Brief at 4. Accordingly, the Rate Board should adopt PLUG's recommendation and require PWD to develop customer protections to ensure its authority to remove customers from the Charitable Rate discount is not arbitrarily applied to increase rates paid by such customers.
