These managers have expertise in various business types, including:



PROGRAMS



The program can reimburse up to 50 percent of the cost of eligible improvements to a maximum of \$10,000 for a single commercial property, or up to \$15,000 for a multiple -address or corner business property.

- Citywide Funding:

 Businesses citywide
 can receive up to 75%
 of the total eligible
 costs, as much as
 \$3,000 for a single
 commercial property.
- Targeted Commercial
 Corridor Funding:
 Businesses located in
 certain areas can
 receive up to 100% of
 the total eligible
 costs.





PROGRAMS



EMERGENCY SMALL BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM Up to \$20,000 in grant support for businesses facing hardship due to qualifying events such as fire, natural disaster, extreme acts of physical vandalism, utility failure, or a highly disruptive public works projects. (Administered by The Merchants Fund)

LOAN PROGRAM

Provides eligible small businesses in low- and moderate-income areas with mortgage loans up to \$350,000 and grants up to \$35,000 for closing costs, along with technical assistance, to facilitate property ownership and promote generational wealth.

An added component to the program providing a grant up to \$35,000, up to 50% of each approved loan amount from a Network lender to historically disadvantaged businesses that meet specific eligibility requirements.
