**Re: Avenue of the Arts – S. Broad Street Median Submission
Proposed Median Development
300 block of Broad Street, between Pine Street and Spruce Street**

Dear Alex:

We represent Avenue of the Arts, Inc. (AIA) in connection with its proposed beautification of and upgrades to the aesthetics of South Broad Street.

As we discussed, I understand that you have seen some of AIA's plans of the overall project to beautify the South Broad Street corridor. AIA is undertaking this significant placemaking project along South Broad Street to revitalize the Avenue of Philadelphia's "Main Street". The project is planned to eventually include the 10 blocks along South Broad Street running from City Hall to Washington Avenue.

Please accept this submission as an Application as part of the Phase 1-A Median pilot project to reconstruct the median and to install plantings, sculpture and lighting upgrades to the center Broad Street median on the block between Spruce and Pine Streets. Specifically, this Phase 1-A includes:

1. Complete renovation of the Broad Street median located between Spruce and Pine Streets, located in front of The Kimmel Center and University of the Arts. Renovations will include demolishing the existing median and installing new concrete footings, metal planter walls, raised granite curbs, and cobblestone pavers.
2. Installation of a new irrigation system.



3. Installation of new electrical infrastructure for future lighting of the plants, trees, and future sculpture.
4. Upgrading of the landscaping throughout the length of the median to include fall and spring season plantings and trees.
5. Creation of a pedestal for a future art sculpture.¹

Concurrent with this Application, we had filed Application #SR-2025-029368 with the Philadelphia Streets Department to request the Department to prepare the appropriate City Council Legislation that is needed to approve the physical encroachments of the lighting associated with this median project phase. District Councilman Mark Squilla will sponsor and support the needed Ordinance Bill. See Councilman Squilla's attached letter, dated May 27, 2025.

In support of this submission, I am attaching the following documents:

1. Median Upgrade Design package, entitled "AvArts", prepared by Gensler et al, dated July 2, 2025, consisting of 11 pages, as revised July 3, 2025. The sculpture depicted is for context an reference only
2. Councilman Mark Squilla's Ordinance Request Letter, dated May 27, 2025.

To summarize, this Application is only for the median work between Pine and Spruce Streets, encompassing new planting, new curbs/planter walls, conduits for the electrical power, and irrigation. This Application does not include and seek approval for the following items for which we will apply later by separate submission:

1. Statue/sculpture artwork
2. Concrete base/platforms for sculptural artwork
3. Art components
4. Lighting
5. Sidewalk adjacent work, including plantings, curb changes, etc.
6. Improvements to other block locations along South Broad Street.

¹ Neither the art nor artist has been selected. That selection process will require coordination with the Art Commission.

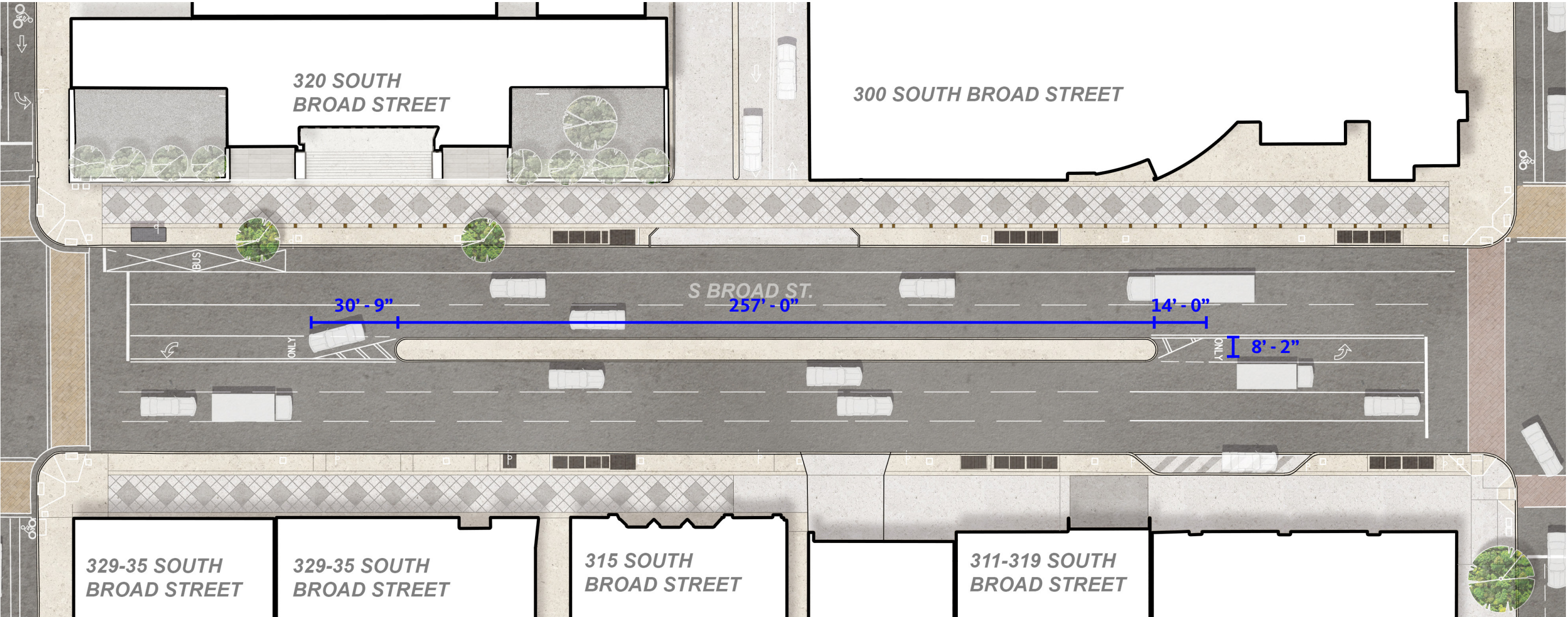

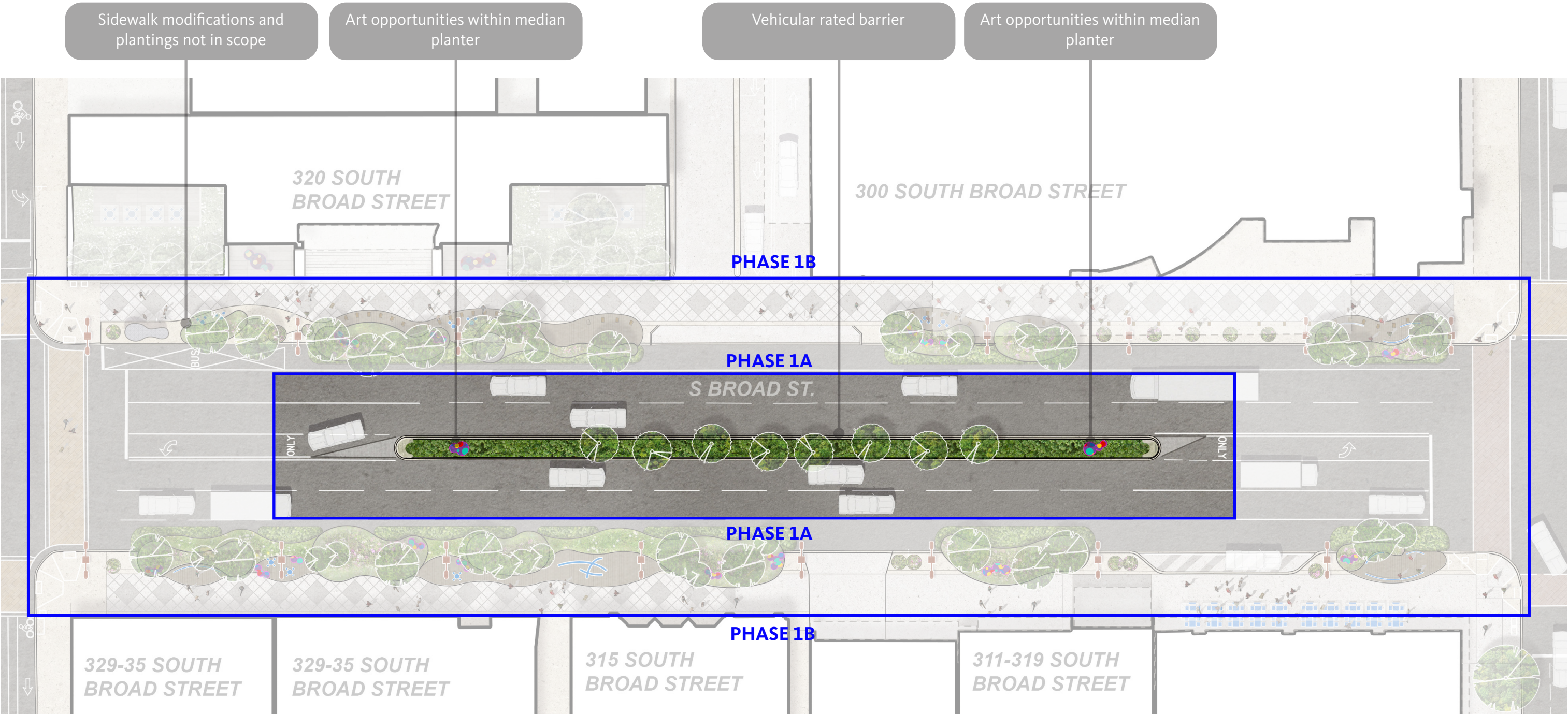

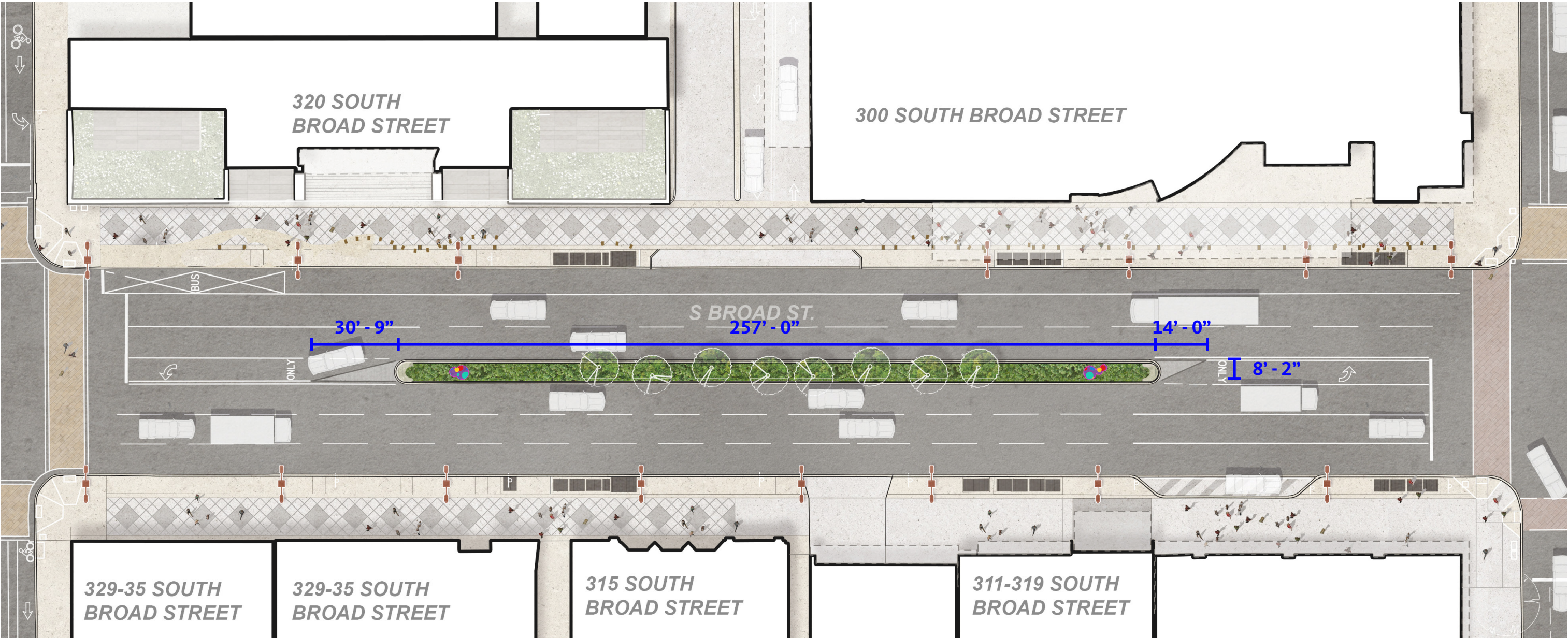

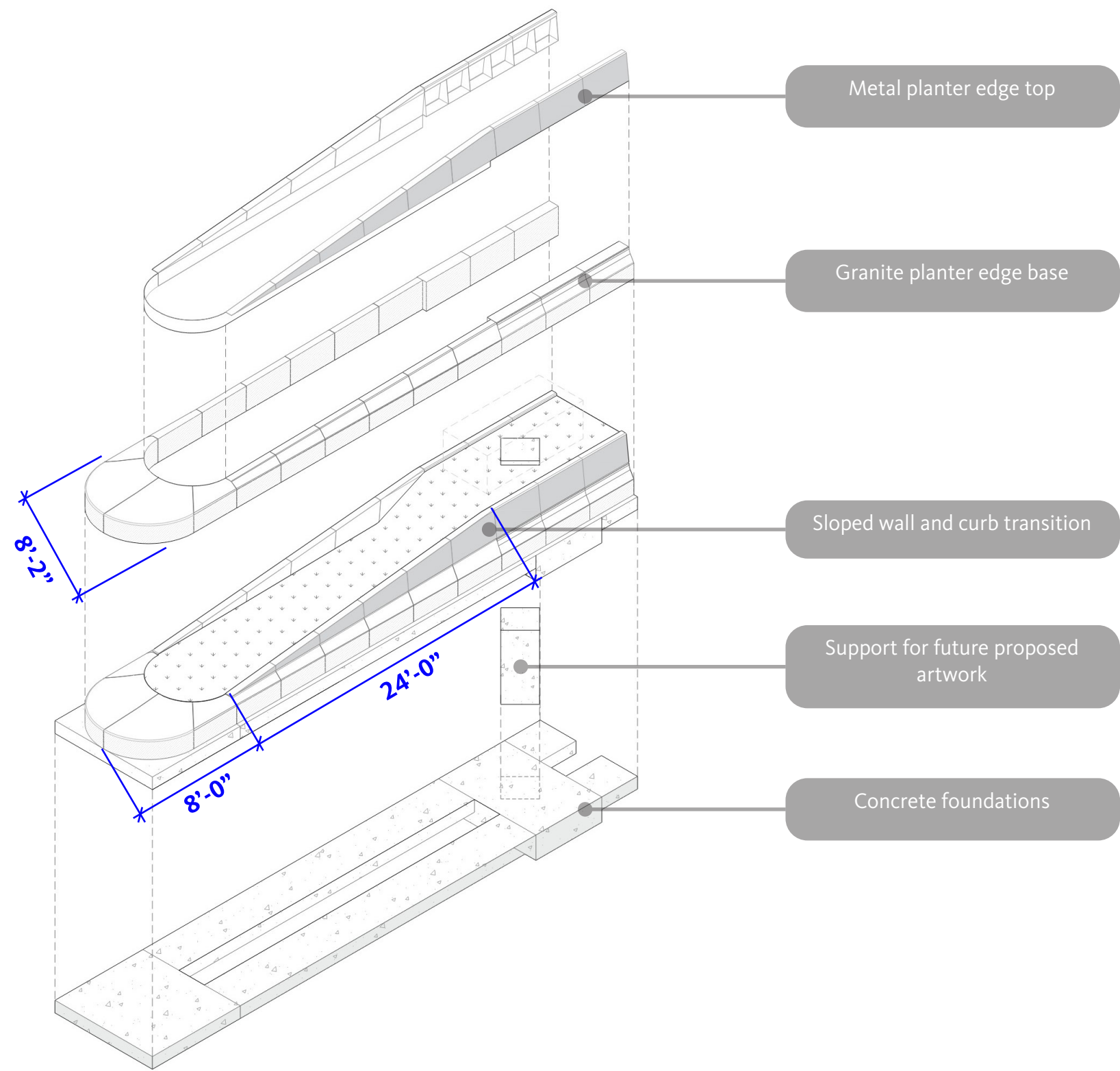
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Proposed Site Plan - Phase 1A



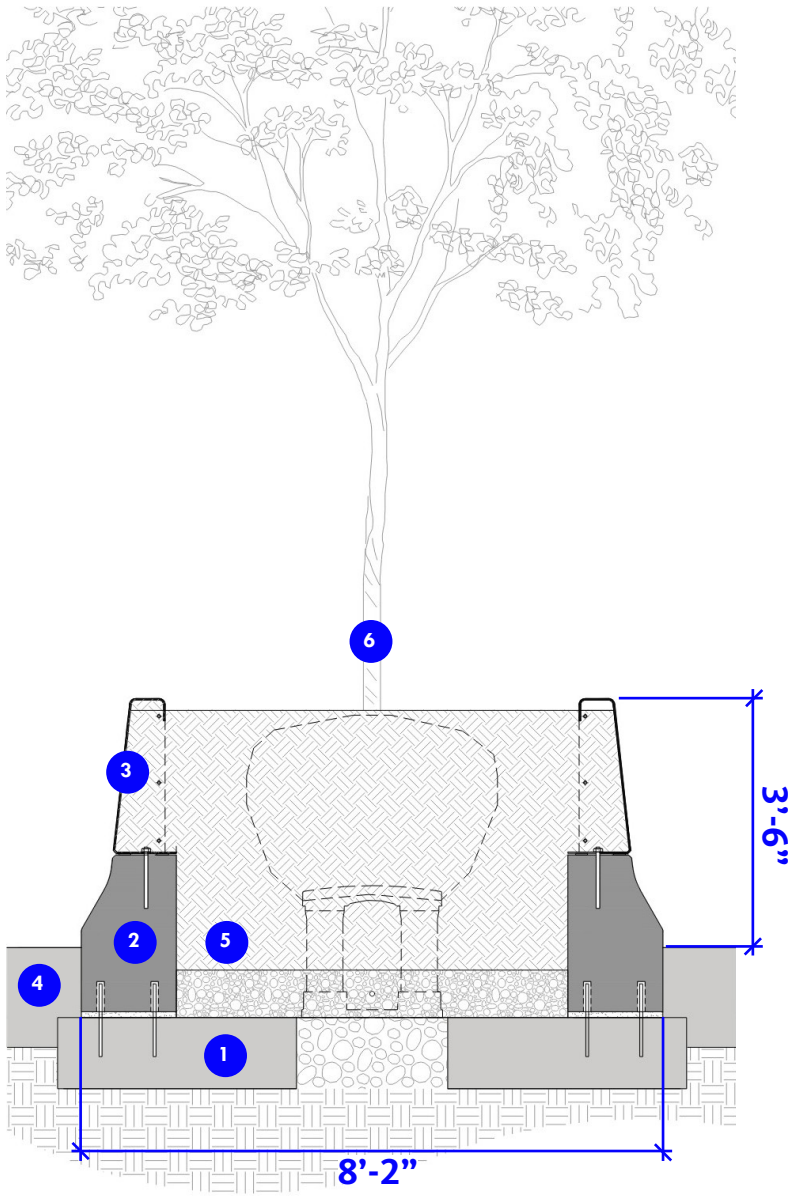

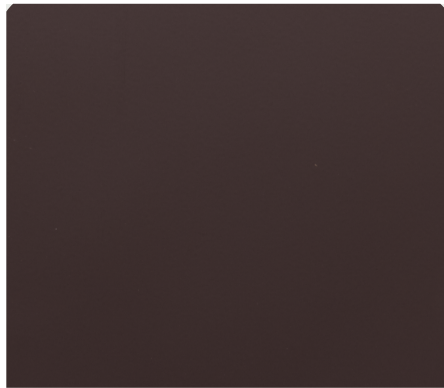
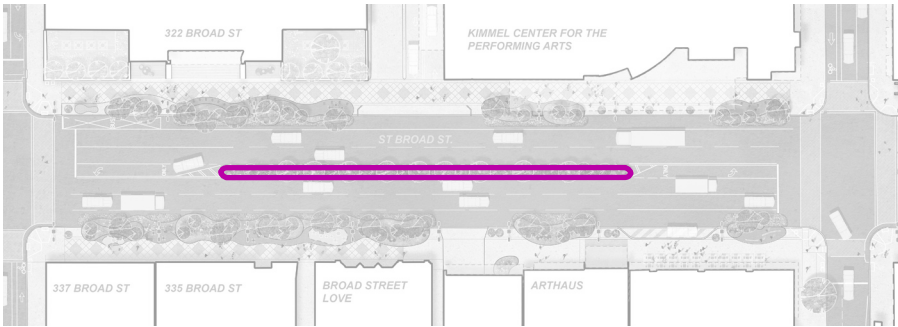
AXONOMETRIC VIEW @ MEDIAN END

- 6 Proposed tree and landscaped area

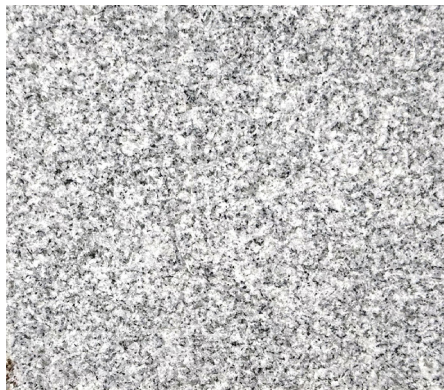

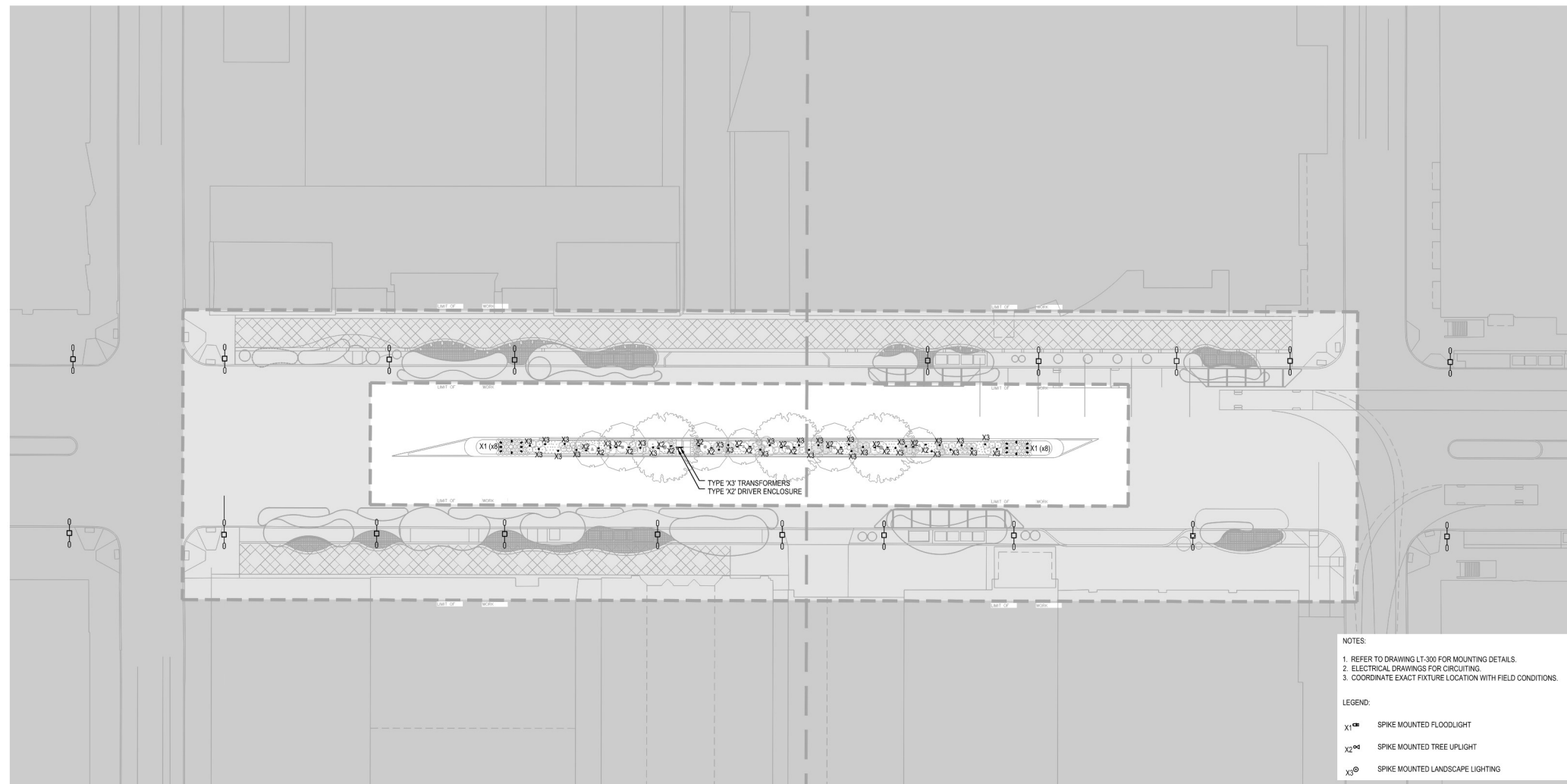

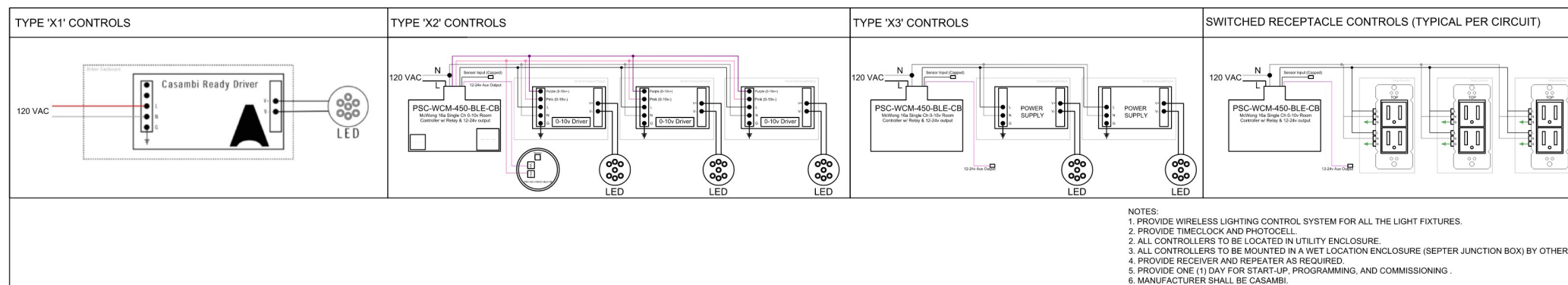

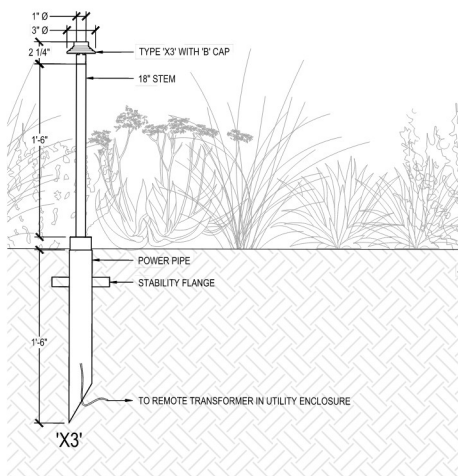
