Chew Playground Replacement; 1800 Washington Avenue, 19146

We respectfully request administrative approval for the playground replacement at Chew Playground located at 1800 Washington Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19146.

The brief description of the project as stated below and the attached diagram shows the project extents.

The scope of this playground replacement will include the demolition of the existing play equipment and safety surface and the removal of two dead tree trunks due to safety concerns. The project includes the purchase and installation of new play equipment in the same location as the current playground, poured in place rubber surfacing, trash receptacles, and (2) additional ADA tables. Existing site furnishings will remain. Existing playground fence fabric will be replaced with the PPR standard black. The project will also include 6 new tree plantings.

Project budget is \$730,000.














PLAYGROUND LAYOUT PLAN


