The estimated project budget is \$600,000.00

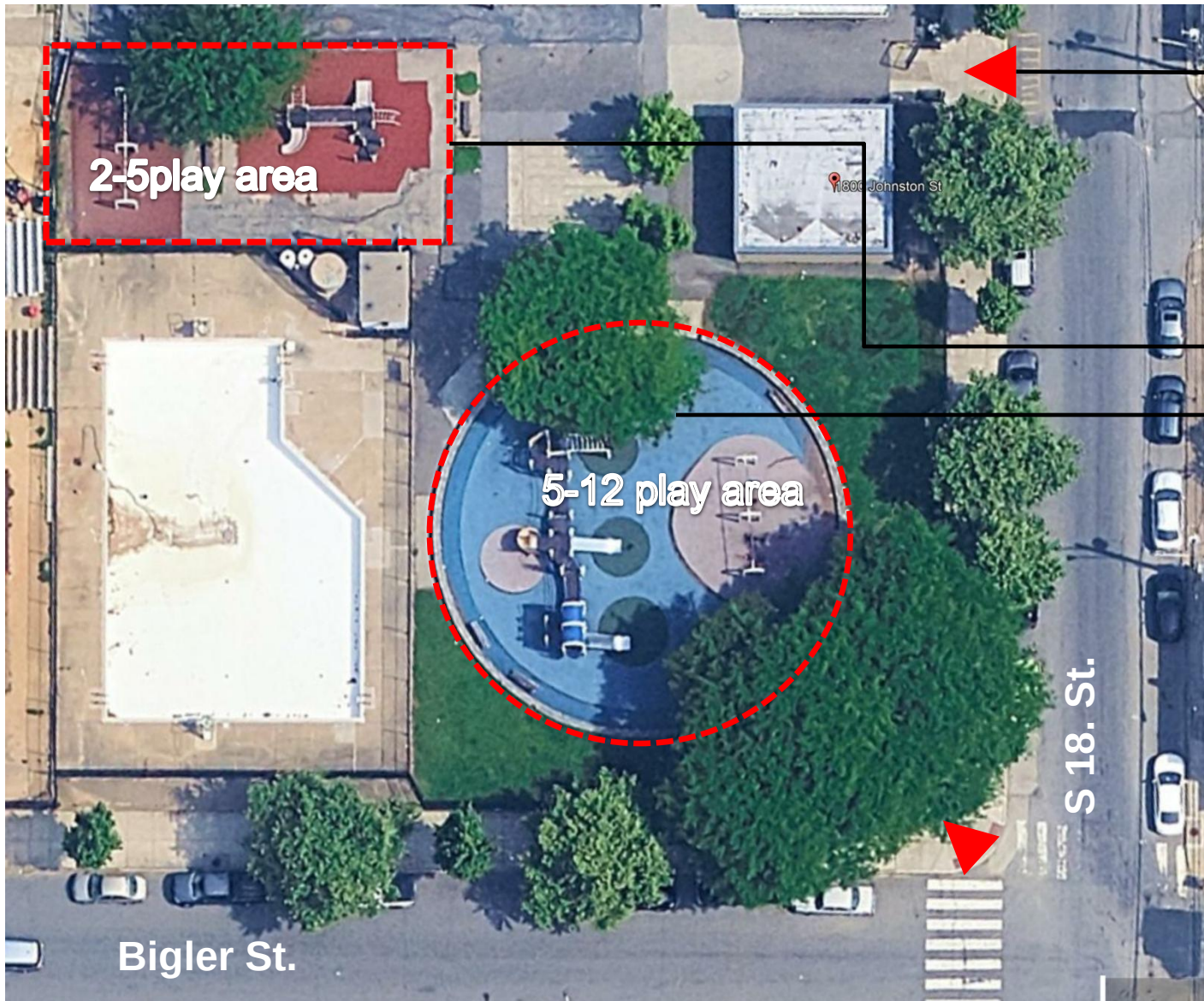

- no additional lighting is proposed

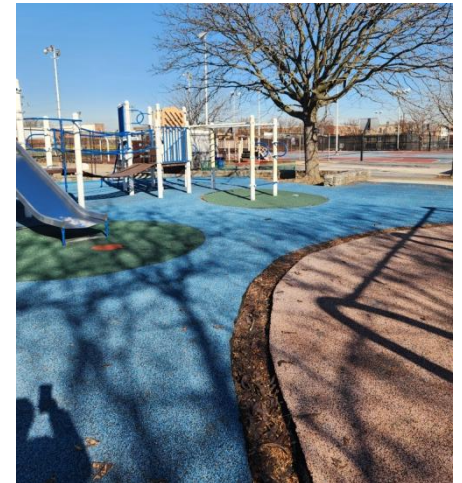


Site Location



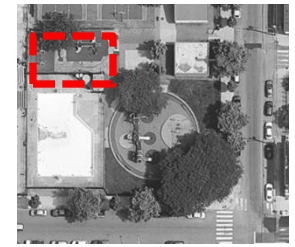
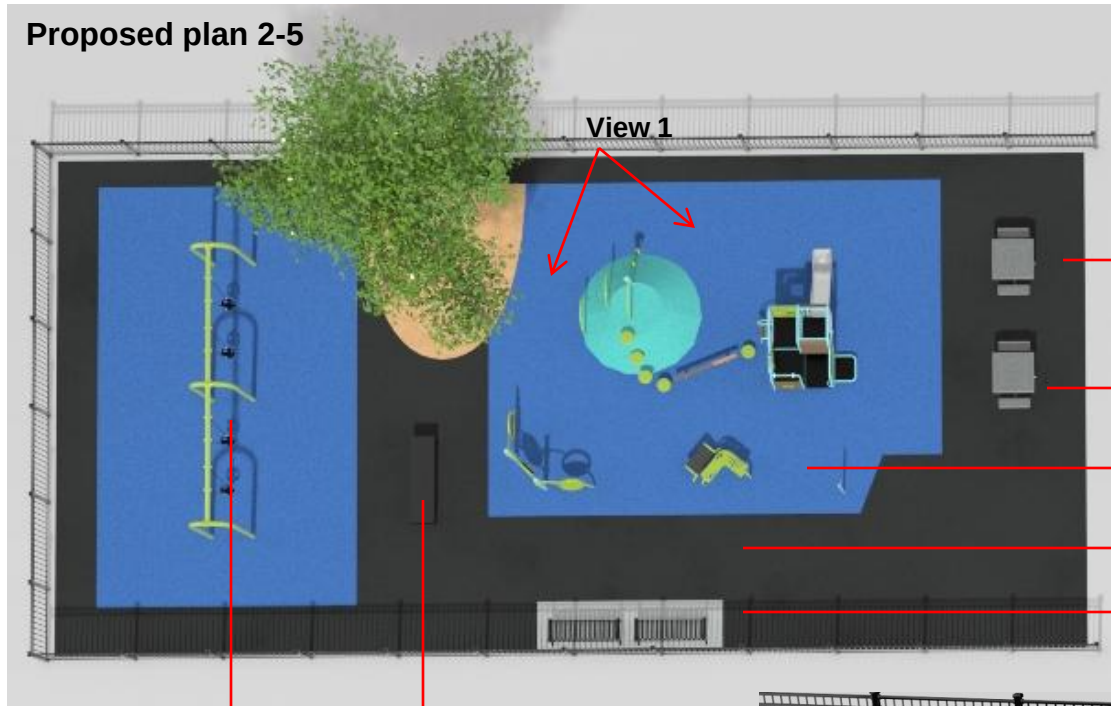

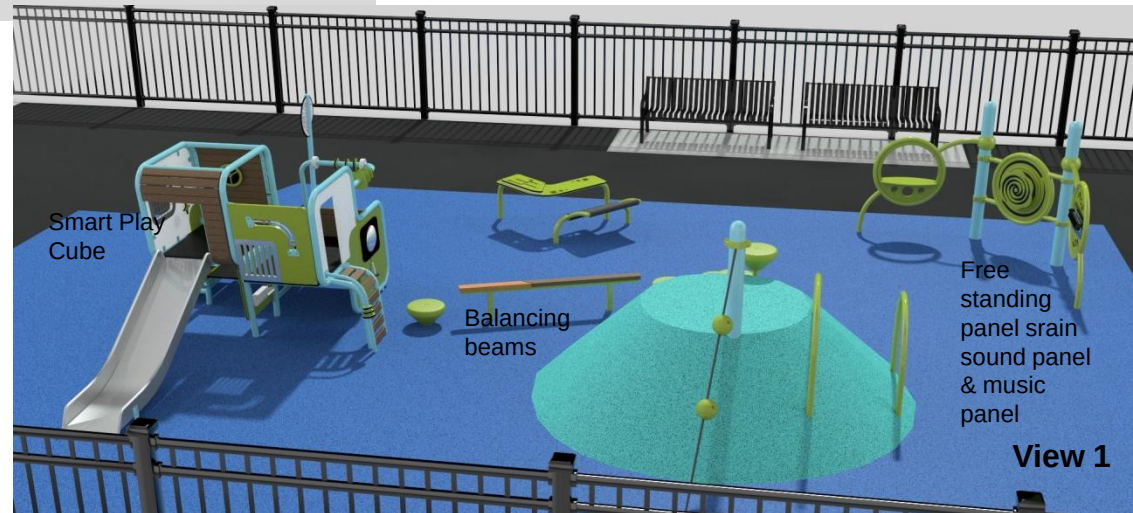

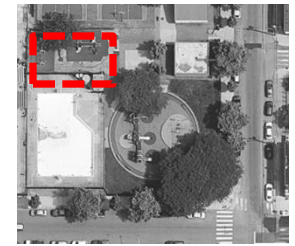

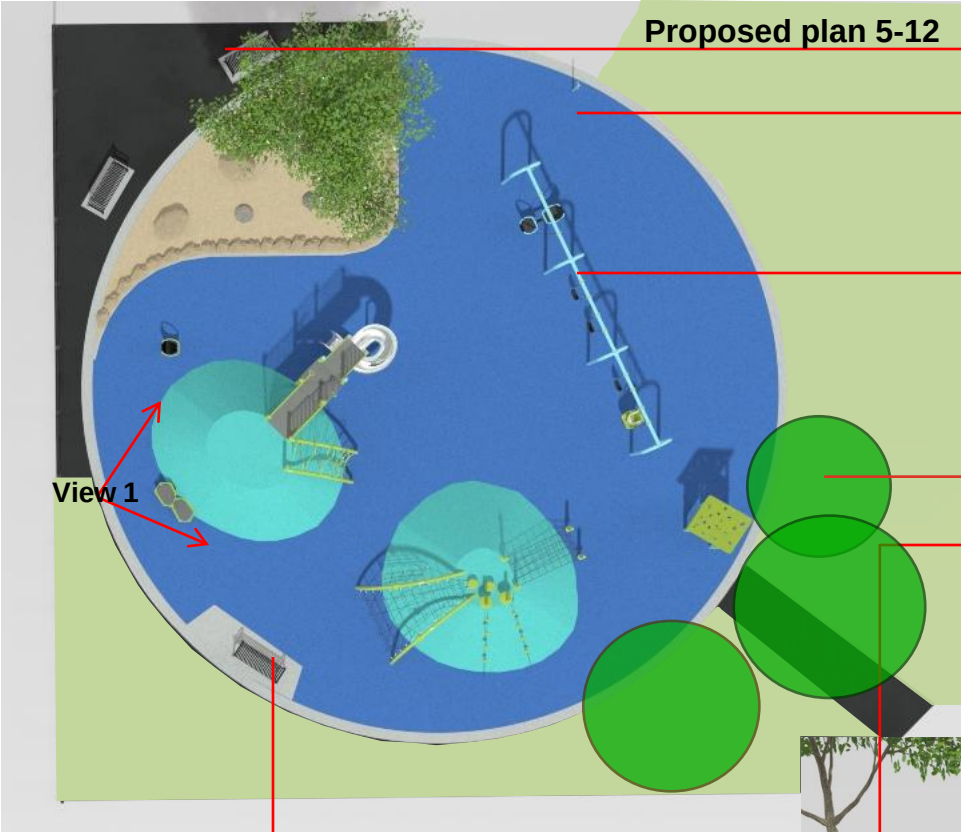

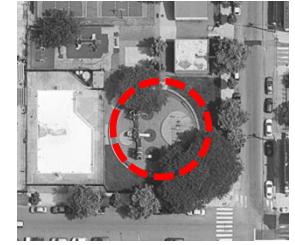

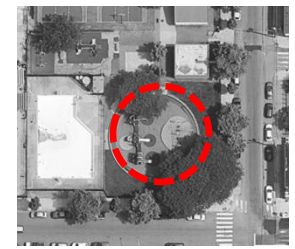
